Call to Order by Chairman.

Chairman Smith called the September 1, 2010 Board of Commissioners Public Hearing Meeting to Order at 5:08 p.m.

Acceptance of Agenda.

Commissioner Horgan moved to accept the Agenda as printed. Commissioner Hearn seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

PUBLIC HEARING:

A. Consideration of Resolution Number 2010-15 which establishes ad valorem tax millage rates for 2010.

Chief Financial Officer Mary Holland asked the Board to approve Resolution Number 2010-15 and gave the Board a presentation summarizing the millage rates' impact to the tax digest, the calculation of the millage rate, and the impact on the average citizen. She emphasized that staff recommended that the millage rates remain consistent with last year's millage rates, meaning there would be no change in the county's M&O, Fire Services, and EMS millage rates. Ms. Holland concluded her presentation by answering questions from the Board.

Chairman Smith opened the floor for public comments. No one spoke.

Commissioner Frady moved to authorize the Chairman to sign Resolution 2010-15 which establishes millage rates and levies ad valorem taxes for 2010 for general county government purposes and for education purposes. Chairman Smith seconded the motion. No discussion followed. The motion passed unanimously. A copy of the request, presentation notes, and Resolution 2010-15, identified as "Attachment 1", follow these minutes and are made an official part hereof.
