- A. Consideration of proposed amendments to the Fayette County Zoning Ordinance regarding 5-40. Standards for Telecommunications Antennas and Towers, B. Applicability, 2. Public Property.

ON MOTION MADE BY COMMISSIONER FRADY, SECONDED BY COMMISSIONER PFEIFER TO APPROVE THE PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO THE FAYETTE COUNTY ZONING ORDINANCE REGARDING 5-40. STANDARDS FOR TELECOMMUNICATIONS ANTENNAS AND TOWERS, B. APPLICABILITY, 2. PUBLIC PROPERTY. THE MOTION CARRIED 5-0.

Approval of request from Director of Public Works Lee Hearn to widen Lester Road inside the Fayetteville City limits at a cost of \$4,500 for labor and equipment; and to place asphalt topping for the Board of Education at the new school on Lester Road at a cost of \$2,500 for labor and equipment.
4. Approval of minutes for Board of Commissioners' meetings held on March 14, 2002, and March 28, 2002.
