

## Fayette County Appoints 911 Director

**Fayette County, Georgia, February 1, 2019** – Fayette County announces the appointment of Katye Vogt as 911 Director. The interview panel completed the interview process on Thursday, January 30, 2019 and County Administrator Steve Rapson made the announcement shortly after.

The interview panel was comprised of Fayette County's County Administrator Steve Rapson, Human Resource Director Lewis Patterson, Chief Marshall Harold Myers, Sheriff Major Michelle Walker, Chief Jane Moon from Peachtree City Police Department and Chief Alan Jones from the City of Fayetteville Fire Department.

A total of six applicants were interviewed over a two-day period; two external and four internal candidates. There were two additional external candidates scheduled for interviews but both withdrew their names from consideration.

After assessing all of the candidates it was the unanimous consensus of the interview panel that Katye Vogt be offered the position. Katye has done a great job serving as Interim Director since early November. She has served in several positions at the 911 Center since coming on board with the county in August of 1992 and her wealth of knowledge will serve her well in her new position.

"We are extremely grateful to have Katye joining the Fayette County senior management team," said County Manager Steve Rapson. "Katye has exactly the type of operational and technical experience needed for our emergency operations."
