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### 1. Call the meeting to order

Commissioner Steve Brown called the August 17, 2015 Public Art Committee meeting to order at 7:00 p.m.

### 2. Approval of minutes for July 13, 2015 meeting

Vicki Turner made a motion to approve the July 13, 2015 meeting minutes. The motion was seconded by Carolyn Cruse and was unanimously approved.

### 3. Discuss Local Art Awards

Commissioner Brown informed the committee that the press release announcing the Local Art Award was sent out to local media on Friday. He encouraged the committee to spread the word and to feel free to submit nominations as well. Commissioner Brown stated to the committee that there is no pressure to nominate someone for every category. Tameca provided the committee with nominations forms to distribute. Tameca reported that no nominations have been made at this point. Vicki will create awards to be presented.

No official vote was made on this item.

### 4. "In God We Trust" art proposal project

Vicki stated that she attempted to visit the location of the artist for the "In God We Trust" proposal, but did not find the location. Kate informed that it is a difficult location to spot and help to clarify where it is located. Vicki agreed to contact another contractor to see what is the

**5. Discuss ideas for Fayetteville Market Day table for September 26**

The committee discussed ideas for representing the Public Art Committee at the Market Day event for September 26. A request will be made to Public Works to have the tents put up and weighted again. Vicki stated that she should be available to attend. Commissioner Brown will not be able to attend. Carolyn stated that she would be available as well.

**6. Discuss ideas for Employee Break Room/Elevator area**

The committee discussed ideas for the employee break room. The committee confirmed the paint color, the use of the wood pallets along the accent wall, possible use of wood panel on the floors and individual canvas paintings from art students from each high school. Commissioner Brown stated that he would reach out to the schools. The committee agreed that the kitchen area could be considered as a phase two of the project. Phil will obtain quotes for flooring and confirm that wood pallets can be used for the wall décor.

**7. Discuss ideas for the County Human Resource Department office area**

Commissioner Brown suggested a *Call for Photographers* to be issued next week on behalf of the committee for photos of all the different departments' staff to create a wall wrap for the entry wall of the Human Resource department.

No official vote was made on this item.

**8. Discuss ideas for the County Animal Shelter**

Vicki agreed to do a demo painting prior to issuing a call for artist for this project. Phil reported that they have priced the siding and no contractor has been decided for the stucco. Commissioner Brown asked Phil to create a plan for how to hang the paintings. Commissioner Brown suggested maybe later selling or auctioning off the paintings to have the proceeds go to the Animal Shelter.

No official vote was made on this item.

**9. Scarecrow Competition**

The committee discussed the dates for the Fayetteville Main Street Halloween Festival. Vicki confirmed that the date is October 24. Commissioner Brown stated that we would announce the competition by press release on September 21 and that the scarecrows should be in the ground by October 17 and 18. The committee discussed having a pumpkin carving contest in conjunction with Saville Studios. Participants could paint or carve their pumpkin. The date would be October 25 from 2-4 p.m. at Saville Studios. A press release would go out on October 5.
