

Current Drought Conditions in Fayette County, Georgia

December 2025 - March 2026

The NOAA's Climate Prediction Center through the National Integrated Drought Information System has released the latest seasonal drought outlook for December 18, 2025 – March 31, 2026.

Fayette County is currently in Moderate Drought (D1), and conditions are expected to persist over the next 3 months. This means that lower than normal rainfall is expected, and soil moisture content will fall below normal.

Less rainfall in the area means that lake levels may drop and be slower to recover. Individuals' water conservation efforts will aid in protecting our valuable resources. Click the "Conservation" link for more tips.
