Gentlemen/Ladies:

Below, please find responses to questions, clarification, or additional information for the above referenced Request for Quote. You will need to consider this information when preparing your quote.

**Questions Received:**

- 1. Who is the current vendor that does the employee drug testing services for Fayette County?**  
DSI Medical
- 2. Who is the current MRO for the employee drug testing?**  
Quest Labs
- 3. What lab does Fayette County use for the Employee Drug testing (Quest, LabCorp, MedTox, CRL)?**  
Quest Labs
- 4. Who currently comes onsite for the drug testing that is required at an estimated 3 times a month?**  
The drug testing company that is currently contracted by DSI is Detect and Protect. It is the owner or a representative of Detect and Protect
- 5. How many collectors usually come on site?**  
Normally it is just one unless they are training someone.
- 6. Are all the drug screens Fayette County requiring lab based drug screens or are there rapid tests as well?**  
We use rapid result tests for all NON-DOT tests. The potential positive tests and all DOT tests are sent to the lab.
- 7. Will the potential vendor be responsible for pulling the random selections?**  
No, we provide a list of individuals to the vendor for onsite random testing.

**8. How far in advance will Fayette County give to the potential vendor to come on the scheduled on sites?**

We typically schedule a couple weeks out from the end of the month for the next month. For example, April test dates are normally scheduled around mid-March.

**9. Are there any DOT pre-employment drug screens to be completed? The estimation for 2023 shows that there were zero.**

We normally conduct most all pre-employment tests as NON-DOT. There may be one every couple of years, but they are uncommon.

**10. How much does Fayette County pay for the following items:**

- a. DOT 5-Panel Urine Test- \$40 each
- b. DOT 5-Panel Urine Test with MRO - \$40 each
- c. Non-DOT 10-Panel Urine Test I with MRO - \$40 each
- d. Alcohol Test - \$45 each
- e. After Hours Callout- \$40
- f. Miscellaneous

**11. Under Scope of Services, it states “Results for drug testing requiring the services of an external lab or MRO shall be provided within 72 hours.” Is this 72 hour once the lab receives the specimen in question?**

We would expect that it would be within 72 hours of the sample collection. A understandable exception to this would be if the MRO had difficulty getting a call back from the employee. But, they should at least attempt contact within that 72 hour time frame.

**12. Who was the previous Contract awarded to?**

**13. What was the final bid of the previously awarded contract?**

**14. What services were provided in the previous contract for the bid amount?**

See pricing on question # 10 above.


