2. The due date for the quotes has been changed to 3:00p.m., Tuesday, January 20, 2026.
3. I would like to point out an issue that I have had with the multilink 10-502-10 power transfer switch you have in the RFQ. This switch does not accommodate the size Awg #6 Traffic signal power supply conductor. The correct power transfer switch is the multilink 10-505-20. The 101-502-10 is a Multilink Manual Transfer Switch (you have to be present to swap it over to inverter) and the 10-505-20 is the Multilink Safety Auto Transfer Switch, which goes into inverter mode (batteries) and back out of inverter mode with no one present to physically do it.

4. Question—do you have a 2200 W UPS going in the cabinet? Maybe an EP-2200 or EP-2200T?
[The Road Department doesn't believe the existing system has an existing surge protection system that can be used with the new system. So if the new battery back-up system requires a surge system, please include it in the battery system line item on the Price Sheet.](#)


