**Subject: ITB 26089-B Thin Lift - Flexgard Overlay System  
Addendum #1**

Gentlemen/Ladies:

Below, please find responses to questions, clarification, or additional information for the above referenced ITB. You will need to consider this information when preparing your bid.

1. The current requirements for the asphalt mix design on this project will not be very cost effective for the contractor considering the asphalt quantity is only 1,688 tons. This type of mix is not common to this area and consists of strict requirements. Would there be any possibility of increasing this quantity to make this a more cost-effective project for the contractor and to promote cheaper pricing for the County? This is a unique process and material that Fayette County has been approved for a pilot project on a limited roadway. In the exceptions page of the bid you are welcome to state for the record on what tonnage to use to make this mix more cost effective from your asphalt facility. If the Department is pleased with the results of the pilot project we will use this information in future bid packages.
2. Due to Metro Atlanta's available local aggregate 40 percent needs to be changed to 50 percent in the supporting document section 402.1.1 Course Aggregate. Coarse aggregate shall consist of sound, tough, durable particles, free from adherent films of matter that would prevent thorough coating and bonding with the bituminous binder and be free from organic matter and other deleterious substances. The aggregate shall be from a source approved by the state DOT or owner / agency and have a friction rating designated in the plan. The percentage of wear shall not be greater than ~~40 percent~~ 50 percent when tested in accordance with ASTM C131. The sodium sulfate soundness loss shall not exceed 10 percent, or the magnesium sulfate soundness loss shall not exceed 13 percent, after five cycles, when tested in accordance with ASTM C88.


