GENERAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS
RFQ 26111-A: Annual Brochure Printing

1. **Definitions:**
 - a. **Responder:** A company or individual who submits a quote in response to this RFQ.
 - b. **Successful Responder:** The Responder that is awarded a contract.
 - c. **Contractor:** The Successful Responder, upon execution of the contract.
 - d. **County:** Fayette County, Georgia.

2. **Quote is Offer to Contract:** Each quote constitutes an offer to become legally bound to a contract with the County, incorporating the Request for Quotes and the Responder's quote. The binding offer includes compliance with all terms, conditions, special conditions, specifications, and requirements stated in the Request for Quotes, except to the extent that a Responder takes written exception to such provisions, and the County agrees to the exceptions. All such terms, conditions, special conditions, specifications, and requirements will form the basis of the contract. The Responder should take care to answer all questions and provide all requested information, and to note any exceptions in the quote submission. Failure to observe any of the instructions or conditions in this Request for Quotes may result in rejection of the quote.

3. **Binding Offer:** To allow sufficient time for a contract to be awarded, each quote shall constitute a firm offer that is binding for ninety (90) days from the received by date to the date of award.

4. **References:** Include with your quote a list of three (3) jobs that your company has done that are of the same or similar nature to the work described in this Request for Quotes, on the form provided. Include all information as requested on the form.

5. **Preparation Costs:** The Responder shall bear all costs associated with preparing the quote.

6. **More Than One Quote:** Do not submit alternate quotes or options, unless requested or authorized by the County in the Request for Quotes. If a Responder submits more than one quote without being requested or authorized to do so, the County may disqualify the quotes from that Responder, at the County's option.

7. **Defects or Irregularities:** The County reserves the right to waive any defect or irregularity in any quote received. In case of a discrepancy between unit prices and extended prices, the unit price will govern unless the facts or other considerations indicate another basis for correction of the discrepancy.

8. **Brand Name:** If items in this Request for Quotes have been identified, described or referenced by a brand name or trade name description, such identification is intended to be descriptive, but not restrictive and is to indicate the quality and characteristics of products that may be offered.

Alternative products may be considered for award if clearly identified in the quote. Items offered must meet required specifications and must be of a quality which will adequately serve the use and purpose for which intended.

9. **Prices Held Firm:** Prices quoted shall be firm for the period of the contract, unless otherwise specified in the quote. All prices for commodities, supplies, equipment, or other products shall be quoted FOB Destination, Fayette County or job site.
10. **Responder Substitutions:** Responders offering substitutions or deviations from specifications stated in the Request for Quotes, shall list such substitutions or deviations on the "Exceptions to Specifications" sheet provided, or on a separate sheet to be submitted with the quote. The absence of such list shall indicate that the Responder has taken no exception to the specifications. The evaluation of quotes and the determination as to equality and acceptability of products or services offered shall be the responsibility of the County.
11. **Non-Collusion:** By responding to this Request for Quotes, the Responder represents that the quote is not made in connection with any competing Responder, supplier, or service provider submitting a separate response to this Request for Quotes, and is in all respects fair and without collusion or fraud.
12. **Ethics – Disclosure of Relationships:** Before a proposed contract in excess of \$10,000.00 is recommended for award to the Board of Commissioners or the County Administrator, or before the County renews, extends, or otherwise modifies a contract after it has been awarded, the Contractor must disclose certain relationships with any County Commissioner or County Official, or their spouse, mother, father, grandparent, brother, sister, son or daughter related by blood, adoption, or marriage (including in-laws). A relationship that must be reported exists if any of these individuals is a director, officer, partner, or employee, or has a substantial financial interest in the business, as described in Fayette County Ordinance Chapter 2, Article IV, Division 3 (Code of Ethics).

If such relationship exists between your company and any individual mentioned above, relevant information must be presented in the form of a written letter to the Director of Purchasing. You must include the letter with any bid, proposal, or price quote you submit to the Purchasing Department.

In the event that a Contractor fails to comply with this requirement, the County will take action as appropriate to the situation, which may include actions up to and including rejection of the bid or offer, cancellation of the contract in question, or debarment or suspension from award of a County contract for a period of up to three years.

13. **Evaluation:** Award will be made to the lowest responsive, responsible Responder, taking into consideration payment terms, vendor qualifications and experience, quality, references, any exceptions listed, and/or other factors deemed relevant in making the award. The County may make such investigation as it deems necessary to determine the ability of the Responder to perform, and the Contractor shall furnish to the County all information and data for this purpose as the County may request. The County reserves the right to reject any item, any quote, or all quotes, and to re-solicit for pricing.

14. **Partial Award:** The County reserves the right to make award by item, by group of items, by any combination of items, or by lump sum award. The award will be made in the best interest of the County. Responders may restrict their offers to consideration of a lump sum award or other restriction only by so indicating on the pricing sheet or the “Exceptions to Specifications” sheet included in the Request for Quotes. Responders who do not restrict consideration of their offers in this manner shall be expected to accept any portion of the award. The County reserves the right to award multiple contracts for the products or services sought by this Request for Quotes.

15. **Payment Terms and Discounts:** The County’s standard payment terms are Net 30. Any deviation from standard payment terms must be specified in the resulting contract, and both parties must agree on such deviation. Cash discounts offered will be a consideration in awarding the quote, but only if they give the County at least 15 days from receipt of invoice to pay. For taking discounts, time will be computed from the date of invoice acceptance by the County, or the date a correct invoice is received, whichever is the later date. Payment is deemed made, for the purpose of earning the discount, on the date of the check.

16. **Trade Secrets – Confidentiality:** If any person or entity submits a quote that contains trade secrets, an affidavit shall be included with the quote. The affidavit shall declare the specific included information which constitutes trade secrets. Any trade secrets must be either (1) placed in a separate envelope, clearly identified and marked as such, or (2) at a minimum, marked in the affidavit or an attached document explaining exactly where such information is, and otherwise marked, highlighted, or made plainly visible. See O.C.G.A. § 50-18-72 (A)(34).

17. **Trade Secrets – Internal Use:** In submitting a quote, the Responder agrees that the County may reveal any trade secret materials contained in the quote to all County staff and officials involved in the selection process, and to any outside consultant or other third parties who may assist in the selection process. The Responder agrees to hold harmless the County and each of its officers, employees, and agents from all costs, damages, and expenses incurred in connection with refusing to disclose any material which the Responder has designated as a trade secret.

18. **Contract Execution & Notice to Proceed:** After an award is made, and all required documents are received by the County, and the contract is fully executed with signature of both parties, the County will issue a written Notice to Proceed. The County shall not be liable for payment of any work done or any costs incurred by any Responder prior to the County issuing the Notice to Proceed.

19. **Term of Contract:** The term of this agreement shall begin July 1, 2026 and continue for a period of one through June 30, 2027. Thereafter, this agreement may be renewed by the County for two additional one-year renewal terms (each a “Renewal Term” and together with the Initial Term, the “Term”), which renewal will be by letter or other written correspondence from the County to the Contractor ninety (90) days prior to expiration of the Initial Term or the then-current Renewal Term. If the County fails to provide notice of renewal, this Agreement will terminate at the end of the Initial Term or the then-current Renewal Term. This agreement is

subject to the multi-year contractual provisions of O.C.G.A. 36-60-13(a).

20. **Unavailability of Funds:** This contract will terminate immediately and absolutely at such time as appropriated and otherwise unobligated funds are no longer available to satisfy the obligations of the County under the contract.
21. **Unauthorized Performance:** The County will not compensate the Contractor for work performed unless the work is authorized under the contract, as initially executed or as amended.
22. **Assignment of Contract:** Assignment of any contract resulting from this Request for Quotes will not be authorized, except with express written authorization from the County.
23. **Indemnification:** The Contractor shall indemnify and save the County and all its officers, agents and employees harmless from all suits, actions, or other claims of any character, name and description brought for or on account of any damages, losses, or expenses to the extent caused by or resulting from the negligence, recklessness, or intentionally wrongful conduct of the Contractor or other persons employed or utilized by the Contractor in the performance of the contract. The Contractor shall pay any judgment with cost which may be obtained against the County growing out of such damages, losses, or expenses.
24. **Severability:** The invalidity of one or more of the phrases, sentences, clauses or sections contained in the contract shall not affect the validity of the remaining portion of the contract. If any provision of the contract is held to be unenforceable, then both parties shall be relieved of all obligations arising under such provision to the extent that the provision is unenforceable. In such case, the contract shall be deemed amended to the extent necessary to make it enforceable while preserving its intent.
25. **Delivery Failures:** If the Contractor fails to deliver contracted goods or services within the time specified in the contract, or fails to replace rejected items in a timely manner, the County shall have authority to make open-market purchases of comparable goods or services. The County shall have the right to invoice the Contractor for any excess expenses incurred, or deduct such amount from monies owed the Contractor. Such purchases shall be deducted from contracted quantities.
26. **Substitution of Contracted Items:** The Contractor shall be obligated to deliver products awarded in this contract in accordance with terms and conditions specified herein. If a Contractor is unable to deliver the products under the contract, it shall be the Contractor's responsibility to obtain prior approval of the ordering agency to deliver an acceptable substitute at the same price quoted in the Contractor's original bid. In the event any Contractor consistently needs to substitute or refuses to substitute products, the County reserves the right to terminate the contract or invoke the "Delivery Failures" clause stated herein.

27. **Inspection and Acceptance of Deliveries:** The County reserves the right to inspect all goods and products delivered. The County will decide whether to accept or reject items delivered. The inspection shall be conclusive except with respect to latent defects, fraud, or such gross mistakes as shall amount to fraud. Final inspection resulting in acceptance or rejection of the products will be made as soon as practicable, but failure to inspect shall not be construed as a waiver by the County to claim reimbursement or damages for such products which are later found to be in non-conformance with specifications. Should public necessity demand it, the County reserves the right to use or consume articles delivered which are substandard in quality, subject to an adjustment in price to be determined by the Purchasing Director.
28. **Termination for Cause:** The County may terminate the contract for cause by sending written notice to the Contractor of the Contractor's default in the performance of any term of this agreement. Termination shall be without prejudice to any of the County's rights or remedies by law.
29. **Termination for Convenience:** The County may terminate the contract for its convenience at any time with 10 days' written notice to the Contractor. In the event of termination for convenience, the County will pay the Contractor for services performed. The County will compensate partially completed performance based upon a signed statement of completion.
30. **Force Majeure:** Neither party shall be deemed to be in breach of the contract to the extent that performance of its obligations is delayed, restricted, or prevented by reason of any act of God, natural disaster, act of government, or any other act or condition beyond the reasonable control of the party in question.
31. **Governing Law:** This agreement shall be governed in accordance with the laws of the State of Georgia. The parties agree to submit to the jurisdiction in Georgia, and further agree that any cause of action arising under this agreement shall be required to be brought in proper venue in Fayette County, Georgia.
32. **Open Records Act:** In the event that the Contractor receives, and responds to, a request for information as provided in Georgia's Open Records Act (O.C.G.A. § 50-18-70 *et seq.*), the Contractor shall promptly provide the County the same information provided to the initiator of the request for information. Contractor shall email such information to the county's Custodian of Records at tsmith@fayettecountyga.gov.

SCOPE AND SPECIFICATION

Introduction

Fayette County Parks & Recreation Department provides a variety of programs for County citizens. The Department makes brochures available to describe events and recreation opportunities. They publish brochures three times each year, for fall, winter, and summer programs. The county seeks an annual contract for the printing of brochures. This will be a 12-month contract, with options to renew the contract for two additional 12-month periods, with the agreement of both parties.

Specifications & Scope of Work

The Parks & Recreation Department plans to place three separate orders for brochures, with 1,000 copies for the fall brochure, 1,000 copies for the winter brochure, and 2,000 copies for the summer brochure. An example is attached.

DESIGN & LAYOUT:

- Designing in full color 8.5 inch by 11-inch finished size folded brochures.
- Fayette County shall provide brochure content in both word and pdf format along with design directions and instructions.
- All images to be provided in high resolution.
- Initial design and layout work must be completed within 10 business days after receipt of brochure content. See attachment as an example of a brochure needed.
- Fayette County shall have 2 rounds of changes/edits to design at no additional cost.
- Fayette County must approve the final proof prior to printing.

PRINTING:

- Printing shall consist of printing of the approved design & layout of the 8.5 inch by 11-inch finished size folded brochures.
- A total of 28 pages, including the outside cover, inside cover, and inside pages.
- The cover shall be 100# gloss white cover-stock sheets with colored ink (4/4) on the outside and inside of the cover. The color extends all the way to the edges of the final printed brochure. See attachment as an example.
- 60# cover stock offset black text ink (4/4) and colored clip art for the inside 24 pages.
- Brochures shall be cut, collated, folded, stapled, and trimmed.
- All costs associated with your quote shall be factored in the unit price and the extended price.

The Department of Parks and Recreation will deliver brochure contents in a pdf file. The Department must approve the final proof prior to printing. Brochures must be delivered to the Department of Parks and Recreation within two weeks of receiving the pdf file.



CLASS STATUS

Classes that do not attain the minimum enrollment will not be charged an administration fee. If a class or program is cancelled for insufficient enrollment, a refund or credit will be issued. The credit for the amount paid must be used for another program/class/trip.

OUT-OF-COUNTY REGISTRATION

Recreation classes/programs/trips are open to out-of-county registrants on a space available basis. Out-of-county fees will reflect a 50% surcharge in addition to the printed fee.

FEES AND PAYMENTS

Payment of fees is required at the time of registration. After the second class, registration will be closed, and no late registration will be accepted. At our main office, located at 140 Stonewall Avenue, Suite 208, Fayetteville, GA, we accept cash, checks, credit cards, debit cards, and money orders. All other facilities and locations are cashless and accept card payments only.

CONTACTS

Some programs listed in this brochure are administered by contracted individuals or clubs who use county facilities. If a contact name and phone number are listed, please call the individual to obtain more information.

LOST AND FOUND

Items left in any of the parks are turned in to the association concession stands or our offices. We will keep the item for two weeks and then donate it to a local charity if not claimed.

RISK INVOLVEMENT

Many of our programs involve strenuous activities and a certain degree of risk. Inquire with staff for further information regarding the amount of activity expected of participants and the risk, if any, normally associated with the program. By registering for an activity, the registrant acknowledges that he/she is aware of the risk, is physically capable of participating in the activity, and voluntarily accepts any risks involved.

SEVERE WEATHER POLICY

Fayette County has made significant strides in preparing for and warning the public about severe weather. If early warning sirens are activated, programs/leagues could be immediately delayed or cancelled for a general time period.

AGE REQUIREMENT

Each class/program has a minimum and/or maximum age requirement. The participant must meet this age requirement within the duration of the class/program. Failure to adhere to these policies will result in loss of registration fee.

There is a point when a program/trip/event must be modified or cancelled. All programs/trips/events require coordination in staffing, purchasing supplies, and transportation. 



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

PAVILION FACILITIES

Fayette County Parks and Recreation Department permits its outdoor park facilities to be reserved from sunrise to sunset. The pavilion facilities reservations are on a first-come, first-served basis and may only be reserved once every six weeks in advance of the date of the occasion (rescheduling is not permitted)*. You must be at least 21 to reserve a facility. A group representative will be required to sign a rental agreement form and pay the fees that apply. The reservation fee may be in the form of cash, check, or credit cards (reservation fees are nonrefundable). To make your reservation, you must come to our office between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m., Monday through Friday.

Reservations for the weekend must be made by noon on Thursday of that week. Proof of residency will be required! Reservation time should include your setup time and cleanup time. A reservation permit is given at the time of reservation and should be kept with you at all times while at the park. Reservations are limited to facilities and time frame listed on the permit. ***INCLEMENT WEATHER: If your event is cancelled due to rain on the reservation day, you may reschedule your event. The individual who reserved the facility must contact our office within two business days after the reservation date. The six weeks in advance rule does not apply, and rescheduling is based on availability.**

FCPRD PROGRAM REFUND

All program fees are payable in advance to Fayette County Parks and Recreation Department. A person is considered registered when payment is received and processed. At our main office, located at 140 Stonewall Avenue, Suite 208, Fayetteville, GA, we accept cash, checks, credit cards, debit cards, and money orders. All other facilities and locations are cashless and accept card payments only. Individuals must verify that their registration information has been received.

1. Classes that do not attain the minimum enrollment will be cancelled two days before the scheduled start and participants will receive a full refund.
2. Refunds will be given to participants if requested in writing at least two workdays before a class/program/trip. An administration fee will be charged for any written refund request.
3. Refunds will be given after a class/program/trip begins only with a doctor's statement of the participant's incapacitation, illness, or injury within five working days from the start of the class.
4. If payment is made online, there will not be a refund for the service fees.

WHAT'S THAT NOISE!

When you hear the emergency warning sirens in Fayette County Parks and Recreation areas you need to take immediate action. The Fayette County 911 Center will sound for the following conditions:

- A tornado warning is issued by the National Weather Service for Fayette County.
- A severe thunderstorm warning issued by the National Weather Service for Fayette County with winds of 80 mph or greater and/or hail greater than 2.5 inches in diameter.
- A confirmed tornado sighting by a credible source.

The Fayette County 911 Center will announce a verbal warning message (no siren tones) in recreation areas when the following occurs:

- A severe thunderstorm warning with expected wind speed of less than 80 mph and/or hail less than 2.5 inches in diameter.
- A significant weather advisory (SWA) accompanied by lightning, hail, and strong winds.

TAKE IMMEDIATE ACTION

- When siren sounds or verbal warning is given immediately leave and seek shelter in a safe area.
- If during a storm you are outside in an open area away from shelters, lie flat on the ground away from trees until the storm passes.
- Tune to a local radio station for weather updates.
