

November 8, 2022, Special Called Municipal Election

When is the special election municipal election?

The special election shall be conducted on Tuesday, November 8, 2022, for the purpose of electing a council member for Post 3. The candidate elected in said election shall serve the remainder of the term for Post 3, which ends December 31, 2025. The runoff election, if needed, will be on December 6, 2022.

(Candidates must receive 50% plus one vote to win the seat).

How long is the term?

The term ends December 31, 2025

When can I announce my candidacy for office?

A candidate may announce at any time but must register with the City Clerk's office **before accepting any campaign contributions**. Regular reports on campaign funds and expenditures will also be required.

Qualifying begins at 8:30 a.m. on **Wednesday, September 14th**, and ends at 4:30 p.m. on **Friday, September 16th**, at City Hall.

What forms are due in addition to the qualifying affidavits?

All forms are filed at the City Clerk's office:

- **DOI** - Declaration of Intent to Accept Campaign Contributions (must be filed before accepting any contributions)
- **RC** – Registration of a Campaign Committee (if you will have a committee working for your campaign)
- **NOC** - Notice of Candidacy and Affidavit – This is the Qualifying Form due August 16-20th.
- **CCDR**– Campaign Contribution Disclosure Report
 - *Affidavit of \$2,500 or less in total contributions eliminates filing requirement*
 - *If contributions/expenditures exceed \$2,500 but are less than \$5,000, Candidate shall be required to file the 06/30 and 12/31 reports*
 - *If no affidavit has been filed, the Candidate shall file per the following schedule: 01/31, 04/30, 06/30, 09/30, 10/25 and 12/31*
- **PFDR** – Personal Financial Disclosure Report – due 15 days after the candidate's qualifying date.

What is the qualifying fee?

The qualifying fee for a Council Post is \$432. This is 3% of the annual 2022 salary for these seats and is the minimum amount required by State law.

What other qualifications do I have to meet? A candidate must be at least 21 years old, registered, and eligible to vote in the election, and must be a Peachtree City resident for at least six months prior to the election.
