#### **Old Business:**

- Rims are still not installed on outdoor basketball goals.

- Question was raised regarding reopening of parks for tournaments. Tabled to February to see where Covid cases trend to.
- Meetings Dates need to be set with youth associations since President's meeting was canceled. Dates set were: March – Brooks and FCBA, April – softball and soccer, May – football and basketball, June – rowing. Dates can be moved around if associations need to switch
- FY2021 updates:

Brooks - Price quotes for cameras in Brooks are being obtained. Public works taking out a small portion of road in Brooks Park and conducting grading work to help eliminate water run off onto the fields. Finished softball concession stand

Kenwood – phase 2 of playground completed. New shade structure up soon. Old playground shut down due to safety concerns. Replacement parts to refurbish this playground have been ordered.

McCurry – repainting all buildings. RFP on North McCurry restroom. Public works paving in softball and football parking. Track is almost completed

Kiwanis – all dugouts are done on upper fields. Safety netting for field 7 RFQ canceled. Needs a ball trajectory study

All parks need to have front entrance signs redone. Scoreboard blanks will be done with Fayette County logo and field number

Splash pad and Equestrian park still under consideration

**New Business:**

2021 initiatives:

- Better basketball courts at Kiwanis Park
- Review background check policy to see if anything needs to be added
- Raffle policy – currently there is not one but needs to be looked at to possibly add one. Check out state laws for raffles
