Old Business:

- New Members given an explanation of why background checks, code of conduct and code of ethics sheets are done for Recreation Commission

New Business:

- Ongoing Projects:
 1. Trying to complete shade structures over playgrounds. Hope to complete this week
 2. Flooring being completed at Field House and restrooms at Kiwanis Park (being painted).
 3. Pickle ball courts at Kiwanis Park. 6 courts came in at a \$1,000,000 cost and the money is not available for that price. Have asked for a redesign. A change request has been submitted for a redesign to a 4 court to bring cost down. The 6 court design was going to require a retaining wall to be built for 6 court design. Courts will not have lights.
 4. Multi-use facility – change order submitted due to plans having a larger footprint that was voted on. Still in negotiations.
 5. Marketing for SPLOST will begin soon

6. Shirelle asked about possible coverings at parks for workout classes. These could be added to the grass in open areas (if available). Currently some groups are gathering the cul-de-sacs at Kenwood and McCurry Park.
