- Fayette County M&O Overview
  - Greg Owenby provided an overview of the M&O services provided to the associations and parks by the county.
- Parks and Recreation
  - CPR and AED classes will be held in April. Anita to provide dates
  - John Feldt and Pete Nelms to will provide a severe weather training program to be offered in March to the county recreation associations
  - Capital Improvements review
    - Field lights, parking lots, and the gym have all been upgraded
  - Kenwood Park
    - Site work is about 75% complete. Tentatively schedule for completion in the fall or by the end of the year 2007 weather permitting

## Annual Retreat

- Soccer – Chris Williams
  - Participation age range 4 to 19 and participation is up by about 100
  - Maintenance and repair is costly and time consuming. Boy Scout participation in projects is very helpful
- Softball – Jimmy Schwab
  - Participation age range for girls is 4 to 18 and is down due to the increased number of travel teams
  - New lighting system works well
  - M&O requirements mainly for painting and general needs
- Archery – Johnny Rodgers
  - Participation is around 8 to 10 archers per week. Very active with scouts
  - Need funding for target centers
- Football – Rick Floyd
  - Need funding for press box and lower field repair
- Brooks – Kent Bishop
  - Brooks will host 11/12 Little League State tournament in 2007
  - Need funding for retaining wall construction
  - New lighting systems work well
