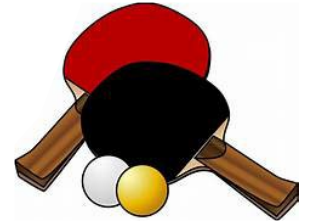


LEISURE/LEARN PROGRAMS

AMERICAN SIGN LANGUAGE I - BEGINNER

American Sign Language (ASL) is a complex visual-spatial language that is linguistically complete and natural. This course focuses on the basics of sign vocabulary, everyday communication, and interaction with individuals who are Deaf using American Sign Language. You will learn the basic components and structure of American Sign Language, the manual alphabet, numbers, sign language terminology, and insight into deaf culture.

Focus will be on Introductions to Classifiers, Descriptions, and Directions. You will continue to develop your knowledge of the Deaf Community, Culture and History. You will have the opportunity to communicate with members of the Deaf Community in a social environment.
