Our hope is to enhance public knowledge on park etiquette as well as documenting potential problems in our parks, and reporting on park usage at various times throughout the day or evening. Our goal is to ensure that the parks are being used appropriately as well as connecting the public to our parks in a safe and responsibility way.

Responsibilities of Partner's in the Parks...

•Establishing a Positive Presence

- 1. Being identifiable as a Partner's in the Park volunteer
- 2. Greeting park users and answering questions

Maintenance & Safety

- 1. Reporting damage to signs, trees, shrubs, pathways, garbage cans, benches, or other park equipment or property
- 2. Reporting potential safety issues to recreation staff

Raising Public Awareness

- 1. Distributing brochures and educational material
- 2. Increasing public awareness on park bylaws and park use etiquette
- 3. Basic information on local plant life and history
- 4. Dog walking and trail etiquette

Information collection

- 1. Collection information on park usage at various hours throughout the day
- 2. Complete surveys as needed
- 3. Assisting with the identification of plant life

•Fundraising efforts

1. Fundraising or sponsorships to supplement park or program enhancements.
