## **PUBLIC HEARING**

- 5. Consideration of Petition No. A-908-25 Martha DeLeon and Juan Castillo Sanchez, Owners. Applicants are requesting the following: Variance to Sec. 110-137.(d)(b). R-40, Requesting a variance to the minimum lot width for a legal nonconforming lot, to allow a lot that is 100' wide to be eligible for development. The subject property is located in Land Lots 70 of the 5<sup>th</sup> District and fronts Corner of Tributary Way and Price Road.
- 6. Consideration of Petition No. A-909-25 James Zacheri Richardson and Louis R. Richardson. # Minutes 10/27/2025

THE FAYETTE COUNTY ZONING BOARD OF APPEALS met on October 27, 2025, at 7:00 P.M. in the Fayette County Administrative Complex, 140 Stonewall Avenue West, Fayetteville, Georgia.

1. Call to Order. Chairman John Tate called the October 27, 2025, meeting to order at 7:00 pm.

- 2. Pledge of Allegiance. Chairman John Tate offered the invocation and led the audience in the Pledge of Allegiance.
- 3. Approval of Agenda. Brian Haren made a motion to approve the agenda. Bill Beckwith seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.
- 4. Consideration of the Minutes of the Meeting held on September 22, 2025. Vice Chairman Marsha Hopkins made the motion to approve the minutes of the meeting held on September 22, 2025. Kyle McCormick seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

## **PUBLIC HEARING**

5. **Consideration of Petition No. A-904-25** – Jose Ruiz, Maria Ruiz, and Jorge A. Ochoa Farias. Applicants are requesting the following: Variance to Sec. 110-125.(d)(1). – A-R, as allowed under Sec. 110-242(c)(1) – Requesting a variance to the minimum lot size for a legal nonconforming lot, to allow a lot that is 2.9941 acres to be eligible for development. The subject property is located in Land Lots 235 of the 4<sup>th</sup> District and fronts Highway 92 South.

Ms. Debbie Bell stated that it's staff opinion the parcel meets the criteria to be eligible for the variance, being a legal nonconforming lot having less than the acreage requirement by A-R zoning (5 acres), but it meets the criteria for the lot size under Sec. 110-242. She explained that the variance is necessary for the owners to obtain a building permit for their house.

Chairman Tate asked if the petitioner was present.?

Mr. James Hodge, contractor/agent, spoke on behalf of the petitioner, stating they found out the acreage was not correct after the demolition of the house previously there, and came to the planning and zoning department with the new plans, and was advised to request a variance to the lot size.

Chairman Tate asked the audience if anyone else wanted to speak in support or in opposition of the petition, but no one responded. The chairman brought the item back to the Board for questions or comments.

Ms. Marsha Hopkings asked staff about the original warranty deed and commented on an easement or septic tank, and if it was still there.

Ms. Bell responded that they would need a new septic permit, and it will have to be permitted by Environmental Health and obtain a new permit if required.

Mr. Bill Beckwith asked staff if this lot was part of the blanket rezoning in place at that time?

Ms. Bell responded No, it would have been A-R when zoning was instituted, but no part of the blanket rezoning.

Mr. Beckwith asked when he looked at the surrounding properties and it seemed like it was subdivided from another lot.

Ms. Bell responded that it might have, but because it was in existence prior to the November 1980 date, it met the criteria to be classified as legal non-conforming.

Brian Haren made a motion to APPROVE Petition No. A-904-25. Chairman John Tate seconded the motion. The motion carried 5-0.

6. **Consideration of Petition No. A-905-25** – Jean Allen Living Trust. Applicants are requesting the following: Variance to reduce the side yard setback from 50' to 20.0' to allow an existing home to remain. The subject property is located in Land Lots 249 and 250 of the 4<sup>th</sup> District and fronts Antioch Road.

Ms. Bell explained staff has recommended the applicant to withdraw the petition since the property must go through a rezoning first, and if approved, then it will come back to the planning commission for some variances that it's eligible for, and because it was advertised, it needs to be accepted as withdrawn.

No comments or questions were addressed by the board.

WITHDRAWN BY PETITIONER, Bill Beckwith made a motion to ACCEPT THE WITHDRAWAL BY THE PETITIONER of Petition A-905-25. Brian Haren seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

7. **Consideration of Petition A-906-25-A-B-C** – 5 Parcel Mills, LLC. Applicant is requesting the following: **A-906-25-A:** Per Sec. 110-143(6).- Buffer. Reduce the side yard buffer on the north property line from 50 feet to 0 feet to accommodate the installation of the septic drain field. **A-906-25-B:** Per Sec. 110-93.- Reduce the septic tank and septic drain field line setback on the north property line from 25 feet to 6 feet to install the septic drain field. **A-906-25-C:** Per Sec. 110-174(5)a.- Street frontage landscape area: to reduce the septic system placement setback from 25 feet to 5 feet on the north side of the SR 74 entrance to install the septic drain field. The subject property is located in Land Lots 8 of the 6<sup>th</sup> District and fronts Antioch Road.

Ms. Bell explained that petition A-906-25-A-B-C has three components and being one project, it will require three separate votes. She read each request. It is staff's opinion that the history of the parcel creates some unique and difficult constraints. The property has a long history of development as a community crossroads area, with homes, local businesses, a church, and a school. It was bisected by the former route of Georgia State Route 85, as evidenced on a 1940 county map and a 1955 aerial photo. This combination of former uses created a property with limited suitable soils for a modern septic system. If the variances are approved as depicted on the accompanying site plan, staff feel that there will be minimal impact on the neighboring property. The area that is the subject of the requests is adjacent to the entry drive and detention pond of New Hope Baptist Church. The property was rezoned from A-R to C-C in 2022 by the BOC. She explained the zoning requirements per each: Sec 110-93 requires a ten foot setback for septic tank and drain field from the property line; Sec. 110-143 its require buffering in the C-C zoning and Sec 110-174 is part of the landscape requirement in the historic district overlay zone and Sec. 110-194 it's the general Buffer requirement. Ms. Bell showed on the maps the buffers and other requirements on the plans and maps.

Chairman John Tate asked if the petitioner was present.

Mr. Rick Lindsey, agent, spoke on behalf of the petitioner, stating that all of the variances requested involve the septic system that needs to be put into the property. He mentioned the property presents challenges to installing a workable septic system because the old Highway 85 bisected this property and stated Environmental Health did not allow them to do that because the soils were disturbed and covered by asphalt for a number of years, and in addition, the Stars Mill Historic Overlay district requires for the development to stay away from Highways 85 and 74 and more buffers by pushing the development to the back of the property. He stated the proposed septic drain fields will be in the northern part of the property, and on the other side, it's the detention pond for the New Hope Baptist church. Mr. Lindsey stated he has reached out to them and sent them a copy of the plans and has heard no objections, and he believes it meets the criteria for the variances to be approved. He stated wanted to empathized will be a coffee shop and a retail space too.

Chairman Tate asked if anyone else wanted to speak in support or in opposition of the petition? With no response, the chairman brought the item back to

the Board.

Mr. Bill Beckwith asked the petitioner if there were any structures remaining from past developments that might interfere with the new proposal.

Mr. Lindsey responded no to this property, and if there are any, they will be turned down. They had hired engineers and that's what they have left to work with and will try to minimize the impact on the other neighbors.

Mr. Kyle McCormick asked petitioner if the neighbors behind the property had been notified of the proposal.

Mr. Lindsey responded on the west side to the left and they have not been notified by him. He asked Ms. Bell if the county had notified them by any letter.

Ms. Bell responded that the county doesn't do that, and there are signs on each side of the road, but the variance request does not require any changes on that part of the property.

Chairman Tate asked petitioner if the property was located on the church street.

Ms. Bell and Mr. Lindsey responded no, Ms. Bell showed the map, providing the exact location.

Mr. Haren commented that the property looks cramped because the GADOT has made some improvements.

No further comments or questions were made by the Board.

- A-906-25-A: Marsha Hopkins made a motion to APPROVE Petition No. A-906-25-A. Brian Haren seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.
- A-906-25-B: Brian Haren made a motion to APPROVE Petition No. A-906-25-B. Bill Beckwith seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.
- A-906-25-C: Kyle McCormick made a motion to APPROVE Petition No. A-906-25-C. Brian Haren seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.
- 8. Consideration of Petition A-907-25 Michael E. Newman and Billie G. Newman, owners. Applicants are requesting the following: Per Sec. 110-125(d)(1)- A-R., as allowed under Sec. 110-242(c)(1)-Requesting a variance to the minimum lot size for a legal nonconforming lot, to allow a lot that is 4.995acres in the A-R zoning district to be eligible for development. The subject property is located in Land Lots 31 of the 7<sup>th</sup> District and fronts Nelms Road.

Ms. Debbie Bell amended the agenda to correct the applicant's request Per Sec. 110-242(h), requesting an illegal lot to be deemed a non-conforming lot. It was advertised correctly, but it's incorrect on the agenda. Staff assessment considers that the subject property was made illegal by actions of a previous owner via a plat recorded on 29 April 1986, more than ten years ago. The plat was for Redwine Quarters, Phase I, and while it did not specifically include this parcel, it created this parcel as a remnant. The petitioner IS NOT a person, or an immediate family member of that person, who caused the subject property to be an illegal lot. As defined in Sec. 110-242(h)(3), there is no property available to add to this lot to transform it into a legal lot. The reduction in area of any of the adjacent lots would cause said lot(s) to be illegal in size, road frontage, or lot area. Environmental Management and Environmental Health had some comments regarding the floodplain and riparian buffers. Ms. Bell explained the configuration of the lot that was the parent parcel on the maps. If approved, the petitioner will have to come back and ask for a variance to the lot size.

Chairman asked if the petitioner was present.

Mr. Jason Newman, son of Michael and Billie Newman, stated he lives in the back of that subdivision and there were aware that the property was not the correct size and had flood plain. Mr. Newman stated that within one acre more or less they had available to build a workshop and not to place a principal residence; they knew less than five acres.

Chairman asked the audience if there was anyone to speak in favor of the petition. With no response, the Chairman asked if anyone wanted to speak in opposition.?

Mr. James Heighton, adjacent neighbor to the property in question, knowing that the property didn't have the correct acreage and had a stream running through the middle and was in the floodplain. He stated that he doesn't agree with someone changing the aesthetics of the area. Nelms Rd is a dirt road; they like the wildness of it and if people buy property that doesn't meet the requirements, like the other lots, why do it? Mr. Heighton stated he does not know what they are trying to do with the property and asked the Board for their consideration to deal with this properly and heard rumors that big buildings are planned to come; they were trying to refurbish cars.

Ms. Hope Winters spoke in opposition, saying that her parents purchased their home in 1977, and to main character of their neighborhood, she mentioned that zoning exists to protect the balance, safety and livability of their community. In this case, the applicant knowingly and willingly bought the parcel, knowing it was less than five acres and all of the restrictions that came with it, asking for a variance to appeal these regulations so they can build multiple structures on a lot that doesn't meet the requirements and the applicant also revealed to plan to a large car restoration without living on the property, having multiple structures since July 2025 including two RV's, shipping containers, a boat, the property reassembles a junk yard. Ms. Winters provided photos of the location with all of the structures to the Board.

Chairman Tate if anyone else was in opposition of the petition, with no response, the chairman brought the item back to the Board and asked the petitioner to come back for rebuttal.

Mr. Newman responded that there are two RV'S in the property, but no one is living on them. He stated that his kids will camp from time to time. The storage buildings are only temporary to store material until the building is done; the vehicles that are on the lot are a project he is restoring with his children; the greenhouse is being taken care of by his parents. Mr. Newman went to the adjacent neighbors with the proposal and his intentions. He mentioned that he came to planning and zoning to get all the information about the property before closing on it and was aware of the department with the acreage.

Ms. Allison Cox, county attorney, commented that, based on the information that has been released and what the applicant has stated is on the property, further investigation will need to be done.

Ms. Bell stated that planning and zoning has not been aware of any structures, vehicles, or RVs placed on the property and there are certain limitations on what can be placed on parcels that have not been developed or even when they are developed, and further investigation will have to be done. Ms. Bell proposed to table the petition to readvertise.

Mr. Newman asked if there was a benefit to doing that versus proceeding with the approval to proceed with that matter separately later.

Ms. Cox stated that because it is illegal, we cannot allow it to move forward to do anything until legal, so it would be better to be tabled.

Ms. Deborah Sims commented that two RVs are only allowed when you are zoned C-H (Highway Commercial) and a campground, and Mr. Newman's property can't have more than one recreational vehicle. She concluded to investigate the property and bring it into compliance.

Debbie Bell amended the agenda to correct the applicant's request, Per Sec. 110-242(h), requesting an illegal lot to be deemed a non-conforming lot. Chairman John Tate made a motion to TABLE Petition No. A-907-25 to December 15, 2025, Meeting. Bill Beckwith seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

9. Consideration of the Fayette County Zoning Board of Appeals 2026 Calendar Schedule.

Ms. Bell presented the last item for the night and pointed out the proposed meeting dates. She mentioned the only day was May changed because of the Memorial Day holiday, and the December meeting had been moved up to avoid the holiday week.

Bill Beckwith made a motion to TABLE the Consideration of the Fayette County Zoning Board of Appeals 2026 Calendar Schedule for the November 24, Meeting. Chairman John Tate seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

### **REQUEST**

Applicant is requesting the following:

Per Sec. 110-242(c)(2), the applicant is requesting a variance to Sec. 110-137.(d)(2)(b)., R-40, to reduce the minimum lot width at building line in the R-40 zoning district for a legal nonconforming lot, to allow a lot that is 100 feet wide to be eligible for development. The variance amount is 25′ (20%), the maximum allowed.

### **STAFF ASSESSMENT**

It is staff's opinion that this parcel meets the criteria to be eligible for a variance to the minimum lot size under Sec. 110-242.

- The lot is a legal nonconforming lot. It is 100' wide at the front and the rear, which is less than the required 125' building width in the R-40 zoning district. However, it meets the criteria to be eligible for a variance to the minimum lot size under Sec. 110-242.
- The lot was created by plat recorded in Book 5, Page 89, on August 22, 1969.
- The variance is necessary for the owners to be able to obtain a building permit for their house.

#### **VARIANCE SUMMARY & CRITERIA FOR CONSIDERATION**

## **Staff Assessment**

*Please refer to the application form for the applicant's justification of criteria.* 

The Fayette County Zoning Ordinance, Sec. 110-242. (b) states that in order to grant a variance, the Zoning Board of Appeals shall and must find that all five (5) conditions below exist.

1. There are extraordinary and exceptional conditions pertaining to the particular piece of property in question because of its size, shape or topography.

This parcel was created by a plat recorded in Book 5, Page 89, which was recorded on August 22, 1969. It is unique in that it is a legal nonconforming lot that is less than the current R-40 requirement of 125' at building width.

2. The application of these regulations to this particular piece of property would create a practical difficulty or unnecessary hardship; and,

The owners would not be able to get a building permit without a variance to the lot width.

3. Such conditions are peculiar to the particular piece of property involved; and,

The conditions are unique to this parcel, and the property meets the criteria to be considered for the variance.

4. Relief, if granted, would not cause substantial detriment to the public good or impair the purposes and intent of these regulations; provided, however, no variance may be granted for a use of land or building or structure that is prohibited by this Ordinance; and

It is staff's opinion that the variance will not be detrimental to the public good.

5. A literal interpretation of this Ordinance would deprive the applicant of any rights that others in the same District are allowed; and,

The applicant would not be able to build a home on this parcel without the variance.

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#### **HISTORY**

This parcel is a legal lot of record documented in a deed and plat recorded in Deed Book 203 Page 430 on June 8, 1979. The property was zoned from A-R as part of the original county zoning ordinances.

### **ZONING REQUIREMENTS**

#### Sec. 110-242. Powers and duties.

- (c) Request for a variance: Nonconforming Lots. The zoning board of appeals may authorize, upon appeal in specific cases, a variance from the terms of these regulations as will not be contrary to the public interest where, owing to special conditions, a literal enforcement of the provisions of these regulations will, in an individual case, result in practical difficulty or unnecessary hardship, so that the spirit of these regulations shall be observed, public safety and welfare secured, and substantial justice done.
  - (2) The owner of a nonconforming lot may request a variance to the minimum lot width for its zoning district. However, no nonconforming lot shall be eligible for a variance to the minimum lot width which would result in the nonconforming lot being less than 80% of the minimum lot width required in its zoning district.

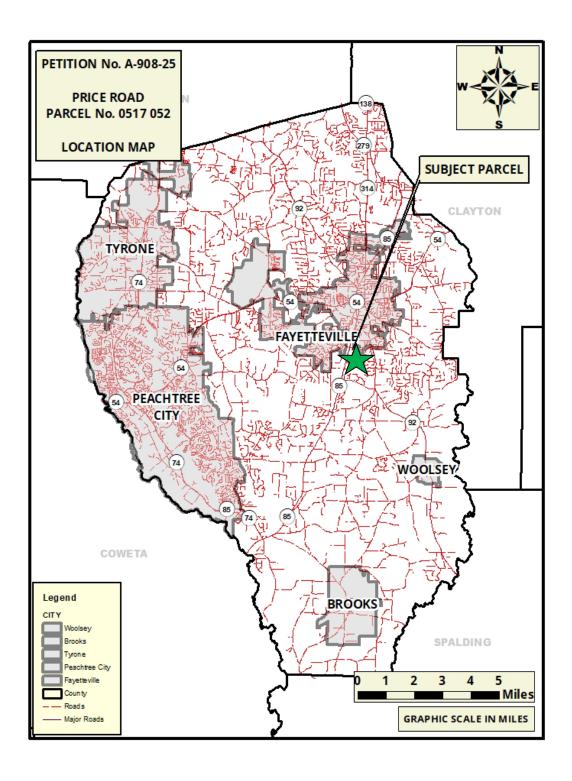

- (d) Dimensional requirements. The minimum dimensional requirements in the R-40 zoning district shall be as follows:
  - (1) Lot area: 43,560 square feet (one acre).
  - (2) Lot width: 125 feet.
  - (3) Floor area: 1,500 square feet.
  - (4) Front yard setback:
    - a. Major thoroughfare:
      - 1. Arterial: 60 feet.
      - 2. Collector: 60 feet.
    - b. Minor thoroughfare: 40 feet.
  - (5) Rear yard setback: 30 feet.
  - (6) Side yard setback: 15 feet.

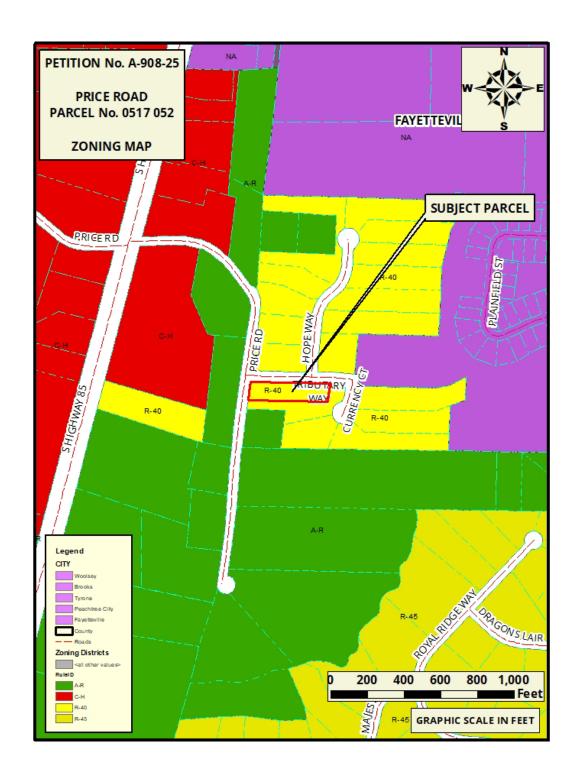

#### **VARIANCE SUMMARY**

The applicant requests a variance from Article IV, District Requirements, Section 110-125(d)(1) of the Fayette County Zoning Ordinance, which requires a minimum lot area of 217,800 square feet (five acres) in the A-R (Agricultural-Residential) District. The subject property is approximately 3.94 acres in size and was legally platted and recorded prior to the adoption of the current zoning ordinance. The parcel historically contained a single-family residence, which was recently demolished due to safety and liability concerns. No reduction in lot size has occurred, and the lot remains in its original configuration.

Strict application of the five-acre minimum requirement would prohibit any future residential development on this property, effectively rendering the parcel unusable for its intended residential purpose and resulting in an unconstitutional taking without just compensation. The variance is therefore requested to allow the property owner, or subsequent purchaser, to construct a single-family dwelling on the existing 3.94-acre lot.

## **JUSTIFICATION OF REQUEST**

The Fayette County Zoning Ordinance, Section 110-242 (b) states that in order to grant a variance, the Zoning Board of Appeals shall and must find that all five (5) conditions below exist. Please read each standard below and then address each standard with a detailed response. Attach additional information/documentation as necessary.

1. There are extraordinary and exceptional conditions pertaining to the particular piece of property in question because of its size, shape or topography.

The subject property was created and recorded prior to the adoption of the current five-acre minimum lot size requirement in the A-R District. At 3.94 acres, the parcel is unusually constrained compared to surrounding parcels solely because the zoning regulations were applied retroactively. The lot size is not the result of any action by the applicant but rather a condition beyond their control. This unique circumstance creates an extraordinary condition, as the property cannot conform to present-day standards despite being legally established and historically used for residential purposes.

2. The application of these regulations to this particular piece of property would create a practical difficulty or unnecessary hardship.

Strict application of the five-acre requirement would prevent the construction of a single-family residence on this lot. This outcome would effectively deprive the property of any reasonable economic use, creating an unnecessary hardship for the owner. The property was previously occupied by a dwelling, and absent relief, the owner would be unable to use or sell the lot for its intended and customary residential purpose. This denial of use constitutes a practical difficulty and rises to the level of an unconstitutional taking.

3. Such conditions are peculiar to the particular piece of property involved.

The hardship is specific to this property because of its unique history and legal status. It is not a self-created hardship. The lot has always been 3.94 acres, smaller than the five-acre minimum, and has functioned as a single-family residential property in the past. Other parcels in the A-R district generally meet the minimum acreage requirement; however, this property's long-standing substandard size creates a condition peculiar to it.

4. Relief, if granted, would not cause substantial detriment to the public good or impair the purposes and intent of these regulations; provided, however, no variance may be granted for a use of land, building, or structure that is prohibited herein.

Granting the variance will not cause detriment to the public good, as the requested use is consistent with the established and intended use of property in the A-R district—single-family residential. The proposed relief does not introduce a prohibited land use, but rather allows continuation of the traditional residential use historically present on this parcel. The variance would not impair the intent of the zoning ordinance, which is to preserve rural residential character and maintain compatible land uses. The construction of a single-family residence on a 3.94-acre tract is consistent with these purposes and would have no adverse impacts on adjoining properties.

5. A literal interpretation of this Ordinance would deprive the applicant of any rights that others in the same zoning district are allowed.

Literal enforcement of the ordinance would deprive the applicant of the fundamental right to build a single-family home, a right enjoyed by all other property owners in the A-R district who possess lots conforming to the five-acre minimum. This denial would be inequitable and inconsistent with the intent of the ordinance to provide for residential use of property within the district. Approval of this variance ensures that the applicant may enjoy the same residential rights afforded to similarly situated landowners.
