The library and our patrons have been adjusting to the changing landscape over the last couple of years. As patrons have become more comfortable with the changes, we have seen new and older patrons return to the library. This has been shown in the increase of the number of patrons served from March 2021 to March 2022. There was a 26% increase from March 2021 to March 2022.

Study Rooms are now open to the public. Although we have a total of 6 study rooms, we are initially opening Rooms 1 and 2 to the public. The other study rooms will be opened eventually

In consideration is repurposing one study room for 1 on 1 technology sessions with a staff member.

The room that used to be the ELL is now going to be used as a multimedia room to be used by library patrons

Amnesty for fines will be ending on June 30, 2022.

Monday Morning Mystery Book Club is continuing to do a combination of Zoom and in-person meetings.

Thursday Book Club will be strictly on Zoom.

Chromebooks and hotspots are checking out consistently and have been very popular with our patrons.

The Summer program Kick-Off was a big success and over 500 children signed up. There were many patrons who remarked to staff that their family had an amazing time and enjoyed all the festivities.

FLINT RIVER REGIONAL REPORT

Natalie Marshall talked about the library tech local collection per capita funding increasing 15 cents from last year to 60 cents per capita. The libraries can use this extra funding to purchase more technology items that the library patrons can use.
