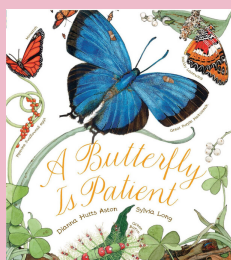


Reading Matters

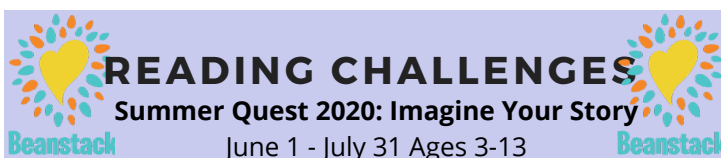
Blank Book: We have turned legal paper into blank books you can take home to imagine your own story.
