Subject: RFP #1229-P: Radio Communications System Consultant – Addendum #1

Gentlemen/Ladies:

Included herein is additional information and clarification for the above referenced request for proposals. Please consider all of this information when preparing your proposal.

1. **Should the SPLOST not be approved, what other funding source will the County seek for this effort?**

If the SPLOST does not pass, the county will evaluate other funding options. In the event that the SPLOST should not pass, the county may delay awarding a contract until alternate funding decisions are made.

2. **What funding source has been allocated or is being sought for the Replacement effort, or will the SPLOST cover that as well?**

The SPLOST would cover the entire project on the county's side.

3. **Who is/will be the technical contact for the County on this effort?**

That is to be determined at a future date, but most likely will be the consultant.

4. **What is the desired not-to-exceed limit for this effort and for the overall Radio system replacement?**

Costs will be determined by competitive solicitations and or negotiations, as appropriate. Budget numbers or not-to-exceed limits are not being released prior to receipt of proposals.

5. **Does the County desire a turn-key system replacement, or a phased approach with multiple procurements of towers, microwaves, BDA's, voters, etc.?**

That is the purpose of seeking a consultant... to assist in making recommendations for the best system for Fayette County.

6. **Does the County anticipate that mobile/portable radios will be needed as part of this effort?**

Yes. They would all need to be P-25 compatible.

7. **Does the County desire interoperability with all surrounding jurisdictions (if so, please name them and the system they use), or only the municipalities listed in the RFP?**

Yes, the county desire interoperability with all surrounding jurisdictions. Coweta County: Motorola, Fulton County: Motorola, Clayton County: Motorola and Spalding County: Harris.

8. **Will the consultant handle the FCC licensing for the radio system, or will that be completed by a third party vendor?**

Yes, the consultant will handle FCC licensing.

9. **Does the Department anticipate any professional or consulting services may be needed to accomplish this effort? (i.e. QA, IV&V, staff augmentation, etc.)?**

Yes, the purpose of this RFP is to obtain the professional services of a consultant from start to finish.


