Subject: RFP #1301-P: Design & Specifications for Fire Station 4 – Addendum #2

#### Gentlemen/Ladies:

Included herein is additional information and clarification for the above referenced Request for Proposals. Please consider all of this information when preparing your proposal.

- 1. Topographic survey CAD drawing. If it is determined that we are able to use the county's topographic survey, will we be able to receive a copy of the CAD (electronic) drawing of the survey? Yes.
- 2. Topographic survey Scope of Work (SOW): If it is determined that we are unable to use the county's topographic survey, and we need to obtain a survey of the area of the site where the fire station will be built, is the county going to contract with a surveyor to provide a survey or does the A/E need to include it in our SOW? Yes, it would be a part of the SOW.
- 3. Geotechnical report. To confirm, the geotechnical services is in the A/E's SOW? Yes.
- **4.** Fire Station #3 site; how many acres is the station #3 site? Station area 3.4 acres.
- 5. Fire Station #3 storage building; there is a small storage building at the rear of station #3 for screening the dumpster and storing lawn care equipment. Is a similar building in the SOW for station #4? Yes.
- **6. Cost of previous Fire Station #3?** The expenditure report for total construction of Fire Station #3 which began in 2013 was \$2,546,000.00. That includes all professional fees, general contractor, and all other aspects of the project.
- 7. Will the new fire station be on a septic system? Yes, the Architect will need to design the septic system. A Level 3 soil survey is not available from the county.
- 8. Is there running water on the site? No.
- 9. Is there natural gas at the site? Yes, there is natural gas at the site.
- **10. Will the future Fire Station #2 mirror Fire Station #4?** Not exactly. Fire Station #2 will probably be a two-bay station, rather than a three-bay station.

- 11. What is the biggest apparatus to be kept at the Fire Station? Quint.
- 12. What is the heaviest apparatus to be kept at the Fire Station? Quint.
- 13. The RFP says the Fire Station should be designed for a 50 year life expectancy. Would this be connected to a weather event, or normal use? It would be a normal use life expectancy, given normal maintenance.
- **14. Is landscaping involved?** There is an expectation of some amount of landscaping, as well as irrigation. This should be comparable to what was done for Fire Station #3 at 420 Jenkins Road in Tyrone, GA 30290. Located on the corner of Hwy 74 and Jenkins Road.
- **15.** Will traffic lights be included in the Scope of Work? No, the county will coordinate this.

  - Attachment C: Fire Station #10 site map.





Fayette County Fire Station #4

Fayetteville, GA 30214



# LEGAL DESCRIPTION FOR PROPOSED FIRE STATION #4.

ALL THAT TRACCT OR PARCEL OF LAND LYING AND BEING IN LAND LOT 139 OF THE 14TH DISTRICT OF FAYETTE COUNTY GA AND BEING MORE PARTICULARLY DESCRIBED AS FOLLOWS:

BEGINNING AT A POINT ON THE SOUTERN 50' R\W OF FELTON DRIVE AND THE EASTERN 80' R\W OF McELROY ROAD AND THENCE RUNNING SOUTERNLY ALONG THE EASTERN R\W OF McELROY ROAD A DISTANCE OF 389.71' TO A 1/2" IPS ON THE NORTHERN LINE OF LAND LOT 139 AND BEING THE TRUE POINT OF BEGINNING : THENCE LEAVING SAID R\W AND RUNNING ALONG SAID L.L.L. N87 34'59"E A DISTANCE OF 809.21' TO A 1" FLAT BAR: THENCE LEAVING SAID L.L.L. AND RUNNING S02 07'44"E A DISTANCE OF 966.72' TO A 1/2" IPS ON THE EASTERN R\W OF McELROY ROAD (80' R\W): THENCÉ FOLLOWING THE EASTERN R\W OF McELROY RD AN ARC DISTANCE OF 134.72' TO A POINT, SAID ARC BEING SUBTENDED BY A CHORD BEARING OF N44 24'24"W A DISTANCE OF 134.69' AND HAVING A RADIUS OF 1819.08': THENCE N46 30'04"W 379.96' ALONG SAID R\W TO A POINT: THENCE RUNNING N45 07'59"W 427.84' ALONG SAID R\W TO A POINT : THENCE FOLLOWING SAID R\W AN ARC DISTANCE OF 323.82' TO A 1/2"IPS, AND BEING SUBTENDED BY A CHORD BEARING OF N32 10'12"W A DISTANCE OF 321.74' AND A RADUIS OF 824.42' AND SAID 1/2" IPS BEING THE TRUE POINT OF BEGINNING.

SAID TRACT CONTAINS 9.877 AC.
