Subject: IFB #1329-B: New Restroom for Kenwood Park - Addendum #2

Gentlemen/Ladies:

Included herein is additional information and clarification for the above referenced invitation for bids. Please consider all of this information when preparing your bid.

- 1. **Does the county have a bid bond form that should be used?** No, Fayette County does not have a bid bond form usually the surety company provides on their form.
- 2. What do we do with the excess dirt? Dirt can be staged somewhere close to project site. Best spot looks to be on the other side of the playground.
- 3. Is the sidewalk to go to the playground only, Clarify? Sidewalk is to connect from where the existing sidewalk stops (see Attachment A) to both the restroom and the playground areas. The small section of sidewalk going towards the Future Pavilion is not included in this scope of work.
- 4. **Are there no liquidated damages?** No liquidated damages associated with this project. The agreed upon project schedule must be adhered to by the contractor per item #14.
- 5. We need the materials finishing information on the building. The materials finishing list is on the plans. For the standing seam metal roof, use a Fabral 26 Gauge Grandrib 3 or equal metal roof system with color to match existing roof colors.
- 6. Please allow more time for questions and extend the bid date? The opening date for this invitation for bids has changed. The new opening date is: 3:00pm, Friday, October 6, 2017.
- 7. What is the square footage of the building? Two different measurement were given. Each contractor is to use plan dimensions to get finished square footage of building.
- 8. **Identify locations of the water line and other utilities?** Waterline is installed nearly 165lf from the face of existing curb line with a pvc stub up at the termination point. Electricity is ran to a stub up conduit pipe across the road from the transformer at the project site.

- 9. Are there going to be any technical specifications provided for the project? No; Use specifications shown on the plans.
- 10. What kind of Split Face CMU Blocks are going to be used? 8" CMU block with the exterior side split-faced and the interior side standard CMU finish. Blocks are to have void in the middle.
- 11. **Standard or Colored? If standard, will it be painted?** Color to match split face color on all other restroom buildings. CMU painted on the inside as noted in plans.
- 12. Are the interior CMU walls going to be painted as stated in the Finish notes? Yes, interior CMU walls to be painted. Or are the walls going to be constructed according to Detail 9 on Page S.1? Finish the Exterior Split Faced CMU block walls as shown in detail #9.
- 13. The schedule of values form does not have a column for quantities or unit prices; will this schedule of values form be revised? Yes. It has been included in this addendum.
- 14. How far form the proposed new restroom will the tie-in to the water line be? Approx. 165lf. from the face of curb at road.
- 15. Will the permitting fees be waived for this project? Yes; NOTE: Inspection fees will not be charged for first round inspections. Repeat inspections needed due to substandard work will be at contractor's cost.
- 16. Do you have a finish schedule or specifications for items to be installed? No; only what is shown on plans.
- 17. Confirm that the waterline has already been run across the road and stubbed up in the general location of the building? Confirmed. Waterline has been ran approx. 165lf from the face of curb at road.
- 18. Who is responsible for geotechnical testing? Contractor.
- 19. Will there be any special inspections required by Fayette County? Yes, whatever the Architect has stated in the plans notes and/or whatever the Building & Safety requires for this type building construction.
- 20. Are we to include temporary fence protecting the area? No, However, Contractor is responsible for protecting their work and keeping pedestrians out of the work zone area.
- 21. Will NPDES monitoring be required? No.
- 22. If we encounter unsuitable soils under the subgrade, how will that additional excavation be handled? Via Change Order, if encountered.
- 23. Has a soils report already been obtained for the septic system? No.
