**Subject: RFP #1431-P: Transportation Engineer of Record - Addendum #2**

Gentlemen/Ladies:

Below, please find responses to questions, clarification, or additional information for the above referenced Request for Proposals. You will need to consider this information when preparing your proposal.

- 1. The advertisement indicates the required format of electronic data to be compatible with Fayette County's software (Carlson/Civil 3D). When doing projects that have State and Federal funding, GDOT deliverables require the electronics format to be Microstation /Inroads. Please address this concern.**

The Scope of Services section of the RFP specifies that CAD file deliverables shall be in a format/version compatible with Carlson Civil Suite 2017 and AutoCAD Civil 3D 2010. To facilitate submittals to the GDOT, the project team shall also be able to provide files that satisfy GDOT requirements for project review, approval, permitting, etc. On a project with Federal and/or State funding, the priority will be for submittals to meet all GDOT requirements. We understand that some software functionality may be lost in the conversion to a file that can be opened by Fayette County. Responders are encouraged to explain in the Proposal their ability, or limitation, for providing CAD deliverables to GDOT and Fayette County.

- 2. There are only a few firms GDOT prequalified in Value Engineering. Must the team have this specific GDOT prequalification in this area class in order to be a qualified team?**

No, a team does not have to include a firm prequalified in Value Engineering in order to be considered qualified.

The Company Experience section of the RFP indicates that GDOT prequalification in relevant class areas is one of several factors that may influence scoring. Not having qualification in one or more listed areas will not disqualify a team but it could result in a lower score for this section.

**3. Fayette County is not in the area where Bat Surveys are normally required. Should that scoping item requiring GDOT prequalification in Bat Surveys be removed? There are only 5 firms GDOT prequalified for these surveys. I didn't want to tie up a firm for these services, if they are not necessary?**

Good point. As noted in the above response, there is no required GDOT prequalification, so it is not necessary to have a firm prequalified for bat surveys on the project team. Teams are encouraged to explain, in the proposal, the types of services they foresee as being most applicable and beneficial to Fayette County and then demonstrate how their team's prequalification's and experience match those services.


