Subject: RFP #1431-P: Transportation Engineer of Record - Addendum #3

Gentlemen/Ladies:

Below, please find responses to questions, clarification, or additional information for the above referenced Request for Proposals. You will need to consider this information when preparing your proposal.

1. Can an appendix be used to include such items as GDOT Prequalification forms, staff train certificates, etc.?

Yes; an appendix may be used.

2. Please clarify the electronic file submission requirements, Item 3 - Submission of Offers – General Terms & Conditions. Is it the County's desire to have 5 separate flash drives as part of the submittal?

Mail or deliver one (1) unbound original proposal (paperclip or binder clip acceptable, no staples), signed in ink by a company official authorized to make a legal and binding offer, five (5) paper copies, and one (1) copy on a flash drive.

3. Item 17 Indemnification – General Terms & Conditions. Per GA House Bill 943, the broad form indemnification is now “void and unenforceable”, particularly with respect to the obligation to “defend”. Please confirm if Item #17 can be deleted or amended?

Response: Item 17 in the General Terms and Conditions appears to basically conform to O.C.G.A. § 13-8-2 as amended by House Bill 943 in the 2015 – 2016 Session of the Georgia General Assembly. However, it may be helpful to responding firms for the county to modify the wording to more closely mirror the language used in the statute. The item is therefore modified as follows:

#17 Indemnification: The contractor shall defend, indemnify and save the county and all its officers, agents and employees harmless from all suits, actions, or other claims of any character, name and description brought for or on account of any injuries or damages received or sustained by any person, persons, or property caused by or resulting from the negligence, recklessness, or intentionally wrongful conduct of the successful offeror, or of any agent, employee, subcontractor or supplier in the execution of, or performance

under, any contract which may result from proposal award. The contractor shall pay any judgment with cost which may be obtained against the county growing out of such injury or damages.

4. Is it the intention of the County to hire multiple consultant firms to perform the services noted in the RFQ?

The county intends to award a contract to only one consultant firm for the services described in the Request for Proposals. Please note, however, the statement in the "Objective" section of the scope of work which states, "Fayette County reserves the right to competitively solicit other Consultants for tasks with fees anticipated to cost \$150,000 or more, that would otherwise fall within the scope of services specified herein."


