Consideration of staff's recommendation to award Bid #1535-B for Dix-Lee-On Full Depth Reclamation (FDR) to the low bidder, Atlanta Paving & Concrete Construction Inc., in the amount of \$89,795.00.

Background/History/Details:

Dix-Lee-On Drive is located in the Dix-Lee-On Subdivision off of State Route 279 in Northern Fayette County. While milling and filling this subdivision, the County came across an estimated 4,500 SY of Dix-Lee-On Drive that was failing due to lack of rock base between the asphalt and the dirt subgrade.

The Road Department's plan is to complete FDR on the first 4,500 SY of Dix-Lee-On Drive, from the entrance off of State Route 279 to around address #240, using NOVA 6" FDR Mix Design with GDOT 2003 Special Provision 301 for soil cement.

The successful contractor will perform the following:

- 1.) Mix the existing asphalt and subgrade soils to a depth between 9.5 to 12"
- 2.) Remove all surplus material to allow 3.5" of asphalt to tie into the existing curb & gutter elevation
- 3.) Re-mix this time adding in 8% or 45 lbs/sy of cement for a depth of 6"
- 4.) Regrade the new road base to have a uniform crown and allow for 3.5" of asphalt.
- 5.) Wet Cure over final FDR mixture

The Transportation Committee voted on and approved project funding through use of 2017 SPLOST funds.

Subject: Invitation to Bid #1535-B: Dix-Lee-On Full Depth Reclamation

Full depth reclamation (FDR) is a pavement rehabilitation technique. The old asphalt and base materials are pulverized, mixed with cement and water, and compacted to produce a strong, durable base for the asphalt surface. The Road Department plans to use this technique in rehabilitating 4,500 square feet of pavement in the Dix-Lee-On subdivision.

The Purchasing Department issued Invitation to Bid #1535-B for this purpose. Notification of the opportunity was emailed to 12 companies on the county's vendors' list. We contacted 148 companies who were registered on the Georgia Procurement Registry. We also notified vendors via the Georgia Local Government Marketplace website (glga.org), the Greater Georgia Black Chamber of Commerce, Channel 23, and Fayette News.

Four companies submitted bids (Attachment #1). One bid was disqualified, because they priced a bituminous prime coat treatment, instead of the requested wet cure over FDR application.

The Road Department recommends Atlanta Paving and Concrete Construction, Inc. for this project. As demonstrated by their Contractor Performance Evaluation (Attachment #2), they are satisfied with Atlanta Paving and Concrete Construction's performance.
