Gentlemen/Ladies:

Below, please find responses to questions, clarification, or additional information for the above referenced Invitation to Bid. You will need to consider this information when preparing your bid.

**1. Will the County be installing the road closure and Detour?**

No. This will be the responsibility of contractor.

**2. How many days of road closure will be provided for the project?**

Road closure time shall not exceed 90 percent of the specified 135 day project duration – max road closure is 122 days.

**3. Will county provide any detour plan?**

No. The contractor shall provide a detour plan to Fayette County's project manager for approval.

**4. Size of the precast concrete bottomless arch culvert - Is the 38' dimension to the outside of the structure or to the inside?**

The 38 foot dimension references the inside span of the culvert.


The deadline for inquires has passed, so the Purchasing Department will not be able to accept any additional questions after this time.
