Gentlemen/Ladies:

Below, please find additional information for the above referenced Invitation to Bid. You will need to consider this information when preparing your bid.

Questions:

1. I notice on section 28 it reads "tent permit". Do we have to have a builders license for this project or do we simply come in and pull a tent permit under our company name? Just want to make sure before I take the time to bid the job.

The only requirement for the permit is that the company be a licensed State of Georgia Contractor.

2. Is a GC License required to bid on this project?

Per the specifications, to qualify bids for consideration a Licensed State of Georgia Contractor will be required for the project.

3. Are any permits required by the county to complete this project?

Per the specifications, contractor shall obtain all necessary permits to perform the work and arrange for inspection by authorities having jurisdiction.

4. Are the footings for the shade structures to be "in ground" or "pier mount"?

Engineered stamped specifications and drawings should include "in ground" footings for the shade structures.

5. I am checking to see if there are formal drawings available for the Playground Shades for Kenwood Park.

No, Per the specifications,

- For qualifying bids to be considered potential vendors has to have the ability to design, engineer, manufacture, and erect the fabric shade structures including the foundations
- Custom design and installation of two (2 separate shade structures...
- All submittals should be 2D and 3D color factory drawings accurate to scale
- The successful contractor will be required to provide the following:
 - o Engineered/Stamped Plans
 - o Statement of Special Inspections
