Below, please find responses to questions, clarification, or additional information for the above referenced Request for Quotes. You will need to consider this information when preparing your quote.

**1. Regarding the removal of the asbestos cement pipe, are there any hazardous waste requirements in handling this line item?**

If the ACP is disturbed, either intentionally or unintentionally, all work associated with it, including cutting, breaking, handling, hauling, disposal, etc., shall be performed and/or completed in accordance with applicable state and federal rules. Fayette County does not have rules for the handling or removal of ACP beyond the state and federal requirements.

If a section of ACP is removed the remaining ends shall be capped.

**2. Provided bid document does not include bid bond format, please address or provide format contractor have to use.**

Please use the Standard Industry AIA bond form.

**3. Are there any Liquidated Damages associated with this project?**

Yes. The ITB identifies a schedule for project completion and a maximum duration for full road closure. Failure to meet either or both requirements may result in the assessment of liquidated damages as established in Section 108 of the Georgia Department of Transportation's *Standard Specifications Construction of Transportation Systems*.


