The Purchasing Department issued Request for Quote #2099-A to secure a contractor to remove dried residuals from the drying beds at both water treatment plants. Notice of the opportunity was emailed to five companies. Another 81 were contacted through the web-based Georgia Procurement Registry, who had registered under commodity code #96893 (Well Pointing Services, Dewatering). The offer was also advertised through Georgia Local Government Access Marketplace and the Fayette County Website.

Two (2) Companies submitted quotes (Attachment 1).
