2. **Interior Painting. Do you want all interior exposed surfaces painted including studs, rafters, trusses, and inside of siding and roof?**

3. **Can we close off incoming water to the intake structure to do work inside structure? What would be the maximum time to have the water flow off?**  
Yes it can be closed and up the max would be 3-days (however as long as the spillway is running then the valve may remained closed).


