**Subject: ITB #2190-B: FY2023 FDR PROJECT
Addendum #5**

Gentlemen/Ladies:

Below, please find an addition to the specifications for Invitation to Bid #2190-B. You will need to consider this information when preparing your bid. The attached pricing sheet has been revised to reflect the change in the scope of work. Please be advised that the due date for questions have been extended.

1. **May wet curing be used in lieu of prime on Hampton Rd as will be done on Wilmington Lane? This will cut down significantly on the mess caused by tracking of prime and sand to surrounding areas, roads and resident's driveways.**
No. The contractor shall provide prime on Hampton Road.
2. **Is milling only required on the turn lanes of Hampton Rd?**
Mill, patch and overlay portion shall require full milling for the new overlay to be at the same elevation as the existing roadway. In addition the turn lane into the church shall be milled to match the existing church driveway and the new FDR road.
3. **All striping is to be paint only, correct?**
Contractor shall only use paint, County will place Thermoplastic at a later date.
4. **Considering the high workload across the entire road work industry, contractor schedules across the board are very tight with no sign of relief soon. Would the county be willing to extend their completion dates to allow more time?**
No. County shall have this project completed in the current proposed time frame.
5. **At the pre bid meeting, It was mentioned that Hampton was split into two sections and that a new scope of work was added for one of the sections while the other section remained FDR. Will the county please clarify the limits of work and type of work for each section?**
From Antioch Road east to the culvert will be FDR portion and from the culvert east towards SR 92 will be the milling, patching and overlay portion. A county inspector will mark the exact transition area.


