Gentlemen/Ladies:

Below, please find responses to questions, clarification, or additional information for the above referenced RFQ. You will need to consider this information when preparing your quote.

- 1. After the Notice to Proceed, how many calendar days are given until the project is to be complete?**
The County shall hold the approved vendor to the length of time stated on the price sheet.
- 2. What are the hours permitted to work? 9am to 6am?**
This project has no restricted hours of work.
- 3. Is night time work allowed at this project? 9pm to 6am?**
Night time work will be allowed as long as the MUTCD Standards are followed.
- 4. The project is stated to be 160', however upon inspection the bridge attachments are not damaged. Would you like this project to repaired from the bridge or starting at the damaged guardrail, please refer to the quantities below.**
 - a. If you want to run the project from the Bridge to the anchor, it would be approximately 244'**
 - b. If you want to start at the damaged guardrail and go until the anchor, it would be 146'**The contractor shall repair the guardrail from where the damage started.
- 5. Is this project subject to Liquidated Damages, if so how much per day?**
No liquidated damages for this work. Similar guardrail repair projects in the past have been done in a very timely and professional manner. We feel this tool to hold a vendor to a schedule isn't currently needed for this type of repair work.
- 6. Is this project subject to retainage, if so what %?**
No retainage will be held for this project.
- 7. When will the award of the project be announced in relation to 1-23-2023 quote due date?**
Hopefully within a few days if references of the low vendor are good.


