**Subject: RFQ #2234-A: Grass Cutting – Lakes McIntosh and Horton  
Addendum #1**

Gentlemen/Ladies:

Below, please find responses to questions, clarification, or additional information for the above referenced Request for Quotes. You will need to consider this information when preparing your quote.

Lake Horton:

**1. Do you want the weeds sprayed around the old foundation located on the hill next to the South Loop/Playground?**

No. Use of herbicides will be very limited.

**2. Do we spray or trim around the guardrails?**

Trim around and under all guardrails.

**3. Can we spray around trash cans and swings?**

No. Trim around trash cans and swings.

**4. Do you expect the park to be cut in one day?**

Park shall be cut completely in no more than two consecutive days unless weather conditions do not allow. Water System personnel shall be notified immediately if cutting schedule is altered in any way.

**5. Do we blow debris off the trail into the woods?**

Yes, grass debris shall be blown from paths.

**6. Do we clean debris off the side of the trail? If so, how far off the trail do you want cleared?**

Debris shall be cleared 3-6 feet off the trail without making piles.

Lake McIntosh:

**7. Are there any food truck events scheduled this summer?**

Not at this time.

8. **Can you notify the awarded company of any events which draw large crowds?  
Because of the crowds, mowing cannot be done on those days.**  
Yes.
9. **Is there a hose hook up or water source for filling tanks (for spraying)?**  
Yes, at the restroom building.
10. **Do we mow outside the entrance gate?**  
Yes, from the gate to the speed limit sign.

General:

11. **Are we allowed to use organic chemicals such as clover oil?**  
Any herbicide shall be pre-approved by the Water System and a Safety Data Sheet shall be submitted with the approval request.
12. **Along the trail, do you want it sprayed and trimmed?**  
Spray or trim for height and to keep any growth from encroaching on the walkway.


