Gentlemen/Ladies:

Below, please find responses to questions, clarification, or additional information for the above referenced Request for Quotes. You will need to consider this information when preparing your quote.

1. Can the excavated material be spread on site? Or will the contractor need to coordinate off-site disposal.

Excavated material may be spread onsite if it meets the requirements of GDOT Specifications 210, 603, and 700. Any material not meeting the specifications will need to be disposed of off-site.

2. Are the Stream Buffer Variance and other applicable permits obtained? Will the County handle if not?

Stream Buffer Variance and permits are not required for this project.

3. What are the traffic control expectations?

The Contractor shall furnish, install, and maintain all necessary and required barricades, signs, and other traffic control devices in accordance with these Specifications, plans, special provisions, and the MUTCD, and take all necessary precautions for the protection of the work and safety of the public. Access to all homes shall be maintained at all times with at least one minimum 12-ft travel lane available for traffic.

4. Is a post construction as-built survey required?

A post construction as-built survey is not required for this project.

5. Are any additional surveys needed or required?

Additional surveys are not required. The contractor shall confine operations, activities, storage of materials, and employee parking within the designated limits of construction as shown on the plans.


