Below, please find responses to questions, clarification, or additional information for the above referenced Invitation to Bid. You will need to consider this information when preparing your bid.

**1. What is the anticipated award date?**

Notice of Award date is dependent on the Board of Commission meeting schedule.

**2. Is there going to be one award notice for a Qty of 1 or 4 units or should the awarded vendor expect to receive two separate award notices for a Qty of 1 and a separate award notice for a Qty of 3?**

Until bids are received, the number of award notices is unknown. The awarded vendor will receive one Notice of Award. If there is more than one awarded vendor, each vendor will receive one Notice of Award.

**3. Chassis manufacturers and dealers are requiring payment for the chassis portion of these projects on NET 30 terms from arrival to the dealer location, which is often months before the upfit completion date. Because of your performance bond requirement, is a progress payment plan negotiable if laid out in the bid response?**

No. A progress payment plan will not be negotiable.

**4. Are delivery charges to be included or will delivery take place at the builder location after the final inspection trip?**

All charges are to be included in your bid. Delivery is to be made to Fayette County Fleet Maintenance, 115 McDonough Rd., Fayetteville, GA 30214.

**5. If delivery charges are to be included, should the vehicles be driven or trailered?**

The vehicles may be driven.
