**Subject: ITB #2316-B: FY2024 FDR Project
Addendum #1**

Gentlemen/Ladies:

Below, please find responses to questions, clarification, or additional information for the above referenced **ITB**. You will need to consider this information when preparing you bid.

1. During the Pre-Bid Conference we discussed allowing the milling of the asphalt on Wilmington Lane.

Fayette County will allow a mix design to be approved on Wilmington Lane that would only include the existing soils and cement (asphalt will be allowed to be removed). As for Hampton Road the County is requiring the mix design to include the mix of the existing asphalt, soils, and cement.

2. Are both roads intended to be milled full width?

The only road that requires milling is the Hampton Road from the culvert to SR 92. The other road will be dependent on the mix-design associated with the FDR process.

3. May wet curing be used in lieu of prime on Hampton Rd as will be done on Wilmington Lane?

This will cut down significantly on the mess caused by tracking prime and sand to surrounding areas, roads and resident's driveways. Fayette County will allow wet curing option for Hampton Road.

4. How much asphalt is on the road?

Please see question #6.

5. Do we have to show what mix design we are using with our bid submission?

Per GDOT specification 315 no mix-design is required when submitting the bid. The accepted bidder will be required to submit all mix-designs for County approval before starting the FDR work.

6. May we have your coring data?

Our coring data is from in-house field crews not from trained engineers. This information is used to help get a rough idea of the existing asphalt depth.


