Fayette County is tax exempt.

**11. From what I understand the new LED screen will be slightly bigger than the opening is right now. Is that correct?**

Yes. That is correct.

**12. Is Polaris the brand of LED you are looking for? We are pretty familiar with Watchfire LED signs. Would we be able to provide a different brand?**

Please refer to *Terms and Conditions #8 Brand Name*. You may list on the *Exceptions to Specifications* page any deviations from the specification.

**13. We need more details on the mounting method for the EMC sign since it is mentioned that the new sign will be mounted on the face of the monument. Do we need to complete the masonry work to fill the hollow part of the monument sign?**

The new sign should be bigger than the current opening so filling in of the current masonry should not be needed. Please refer to the *RFQ Scope & Specification* for measurements.

**14. It is mentioned that the cabinet should be hinged for easy access for maintenance, can you please elaborate on this?**

The hinge will allow the sign to be lifted, rather than removed, if maintenance is required.

**15. Can the sign protrude from the face of the brick monument and not flush?**

Yes. Please refer to the *RFQ Scope & Specification* for the requested cabinet size.

**16. For the existing electrical, how many amps are available currently?**

There are two 20-amp 120 volt and one 20-amp 240 volt available.

**17. Is there a hardwire data connection available at the sign, or is wireless communication required?**

There is a hardwire data connection available. Wireless communication is acceptable but is not required.


