**Subject: RFQ #2355-A Inman, Lee's Lake and Lester Road Roadside Pruning  
Addendum #1**

Gentlemen/Ladies:

Below, please find responses to questions, clarification, or additional information for the above referenced RFQ. You will need to consider this information when preparing your quote.

- 1. Will trimming need to be done behind properties with fences? For example, trimming needs to be done 80 feet back from the road but some areas have a personally owned fence which is located about 30 feet from the street. Would trimming need to be done to the 50 feet located behind the fence?**

R/W value represents total linear feet land owned by the County so 80' represents 40' each direction from the center line of the road. Telephone poles are also a good indicator of R/W because they are generally installed at the back of the r/w so help prevent the future need of be relocated. No trimming will be done behind property fences.

- 2. Are the only trees being pruned the ones inside the right-of-way that are hanging over the street? Not all trees inside the right-of-way whose branches are not hanging over the street?**

We are looking to cut back all limbs from the mature tree line or the R/W – 70' vertically, not just the limb directly over the road.

- 3. All trees under 6" diameter and underbrush located inside the right-of-way are being removed?**

Yes.

- 4. As long as the chipper is located in the woods (pushed back away from the street) will the crew be able to chip up the debris?**

Chips can only be left on wooded areas or vacant lots, must stay in R/W and not thicker than 3 inches. The chipper itself must stay on the County R/W.


