**Subject: RFQ #2383-A: Public Works Entrance Gate  
Addendum #1**

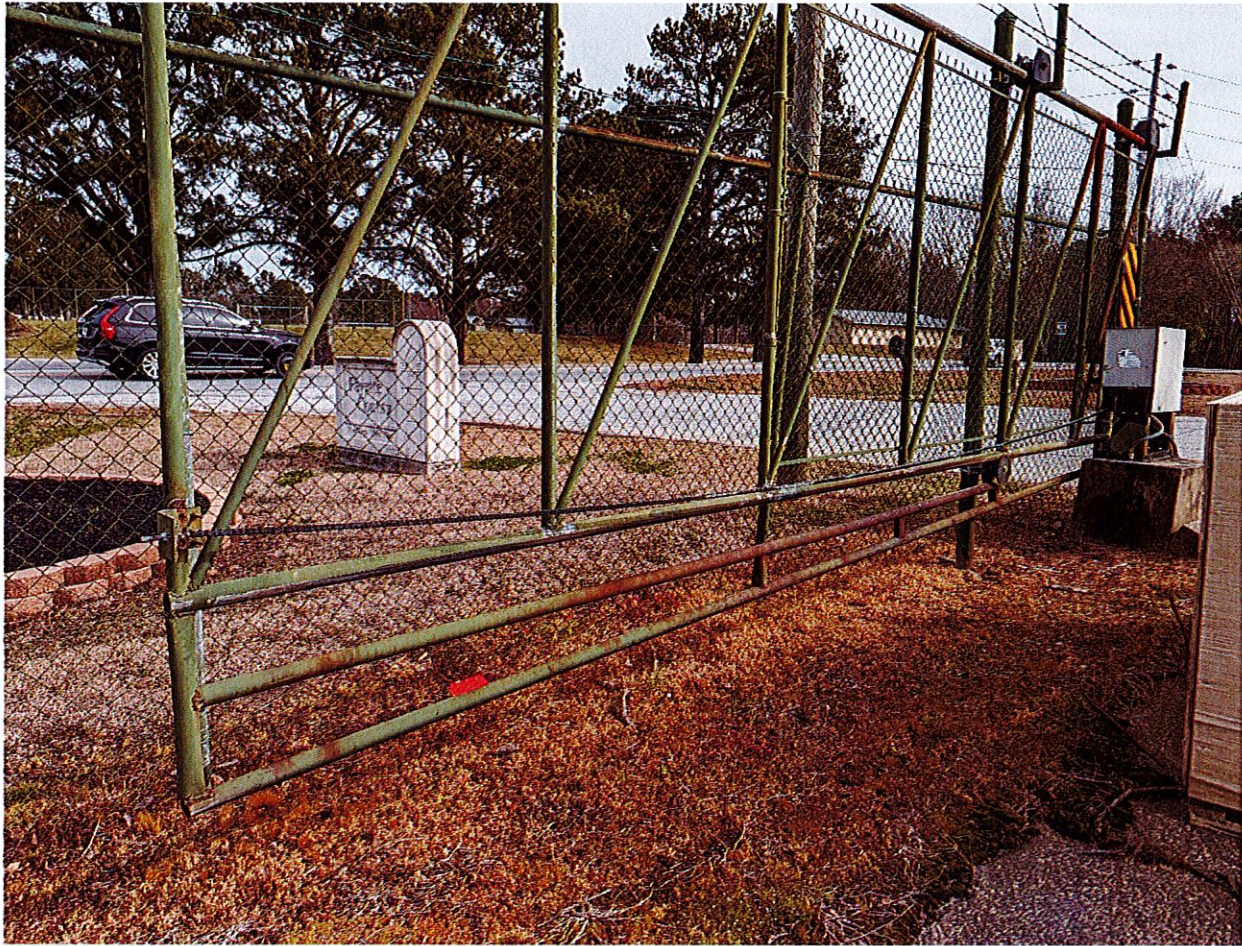
Gentlemen/Ladies:

Below, please find responses to questions, clarification, or additional information for the above referenced **RFQ**. You will need to consider this information when preparing your quote.

1. **What is the height of the existing gate? Doesn't say anywhere on the plans the height of the existing fence/gate. From what I can see on google maps it looks to be 8' tall. The existing gates and fence are 8-ft high.**
2. **From what I can see on google maps the existing fence/gate is green in color. Green is available but with a 3-4 week lead time on material. This will cause an issue with the 30 completion notice on the contract. Will green be required or will galvanized material be accepted? The RFQ does not require new fence material or gates. The fence and gates are not being replaced.**
3. **The existing opening is operated by a double gate. Do you want the same setup(double gate) or will a single gate across the opening be preferred? 1 new single gate will be cheaper. Per the RFQ, the same setup (existing double gate with two new operators) is required. The existing gates will remain in place and use.**
4. **It appears that the wheels on the fence are not covered. Will the contractor be responsible for bringing the gate up to standard. No. This will be repaired by the County.**
5. **Do you want both gates to open simultaneously when the open command is triggered via the proposed Honeywell Access system? Yes**
6. **What function is the safety loop performing in this system? The free exit loop with trigger the gate to open and the photo eye will prevent the gate from closing on a vehicle or pedestrian. The safety loop performs the same function as the photo eye. It is a redundant safety that will sense a vehicle that may be higher than the photo eye.**



7. Will a free exit induction loop cut and sealed into the asphalt roadway surface be acceptable? Yes.
8. Is the incoming AC power to both gate operators available at both existing operators? Yes.
