**Subject: RFQ 2412-A: S. Fayette Vegetation Clearing  
Addendum 1**

Gentlemen/Ladies:

Below, please find responses to questions, clarification, or additional information for the above referenced Request for Quotes. You will need to consider this information when preparing your quote.

**1. What happens if the vegetation, especially the honeysuckle, is tangled in the fence?**

Honeysuckle shall be removed to the satisfaction of Water System.

**2. How do we gain access to the area outside the fence?**

There is a gate at the spillway area of pond dam and at the corner of fence along Antioch Rd.

**3. Clear the area inside the fence to the toe of the dam, except the area depicted in Attachment 1.**

**4. Do you want the large trees removed?**

Attachment 2 shows a close-up of trees that shall be removed which are next to the exempt area in Attachment 1. The larger trees which are to be removed are marked with a pink dot.

**5. Can we use herbicide?**

AquaNeat is an approved herbicide to use near the water, and Contractors shall submit a copy of their Contractor's Pesticide License with their quote if they plan on applying herbicide. Any other herbicide must be pre-approved by the Water System and the Material Safety Data Sheet shall be included with your quote.

**6. Are we clearing both sides of the fence?**

Yes.

**7. Are there any issues with equipment on the toe of the dam?**

No known issues. Any damage shall be communicated immediately and rectified to the satisfaction of the Water System.



The deadline for inquiries has passed, so the Purchasing Department will not be able to accept any additional questions after this time.

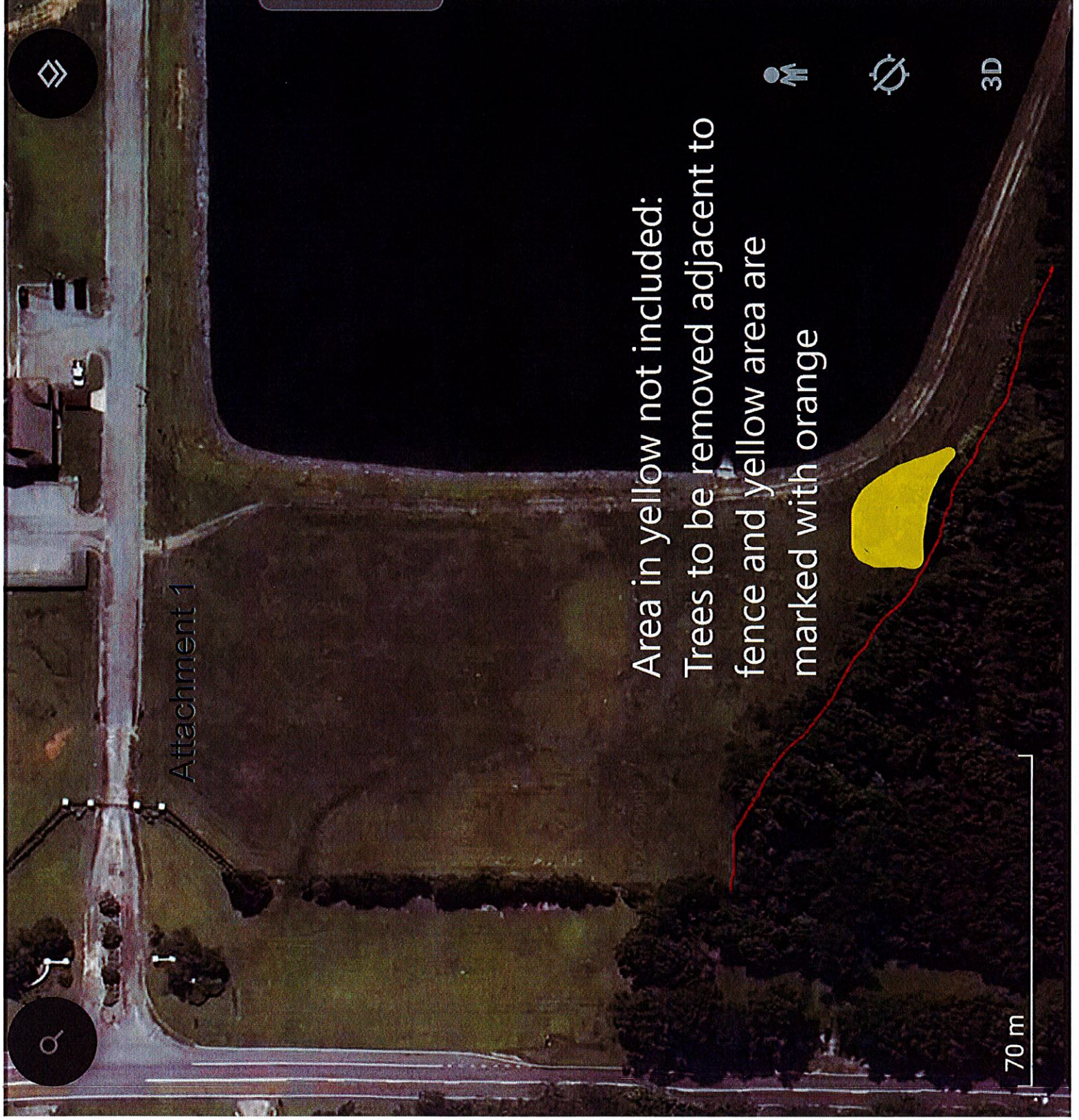
