**Subject: RFQ #2521-B: Grass Cutting Services - Fire  
Addendum #2**

Gentlemen/Ladies:

1. **Who is the current contractor for the fire dept? Is there a tally sheet available?**  
The fire stations' cutting was previously done in-house. This will be the first contract.
2. **Is it the same contractor for all 10 locations? Will you use one contractor for all locations?**  
Contracts will be awarded in the best interest of the county.
3. **Are you requiring the bidder to mail or walk in the bid or can it also be electronically emailed to you?**  
Bids can either be mailed in or hand delivered. Please ensure that envelopes are sealed and show your company's name and address. Electronic bids will not be considered.
4. **The bid states, you can locate the addendum on-line at your website. Can you please email the link to the addendum?**

5. **The bid states this is a weekly cut on Monday or Tuesday, Is there an irrigation system in place and if so, what location or all locations?**  
The only stations with irrigation are Stations 3 & 4, and they will not be set to run the day chosen for cutting.
6. **Will you post a tally sheet after the bid closes?**  
Yes.
7. **There is nothing in the scope about turf fertilization and weed control, so assuming this is to be left out.**  
No. Fertilization and weed control are not part of the bid.
8. **Can acreage be provided for each location?**  
There are no exact measurements, contractor is responsible for measuring.
9. **Pine straw is included in the scope of work, should that be included in the cost per cut or will it be a separate line item? Can historical quantities of pine straw used on location be provided?**  
Pine straw should be a separate line item, and for exact numbers of pine straw the contractor is responsible for measuring. A revised pricing sheet is attached.

**10. Hedge trimming is included in the scope of work, should that be included in the cost per cut or will it be a separate line item?**

Hedge trimming should be a separate line item. A revised pricing sheet is attached.

**11. Will this contract be a sole vendor award or a split vendor award?**

Contracts will be awarded in the best interest of the county.

**12. My question pertains to fertilization. My vendor who does herbicide treatment includes fertilization too. So, it's applied every 4 to 6 weeks and the outcome is better for the lawn. Are you only interested in herbicide treatment (ie. pre-emergent and post-emergent as needed) or can fertilization be included in this scope, too?**

No, do not include any of this in the bid, we do not include this or consider it as part of the scope of work. Also, the wording "my vender includes fertilization" sounds like subcontracting, which we do not allow.


