**Subject: RFQ #2561-A: Dried Residuals Removal
Addendum #1**

Gentlemen/Ladies:

Below, please find responses to questions, clarification, or additional information for the above referenced RFQ. You will need to consider this information when preparing your quote.

1. What Company currently provides the transport and disposal of dried residuals from both plants?

Midstate Contracting

2. Would the County be able to share the County's current prices paid for this service?

3. What are the hours of service for serving the containers?

Monday – Friday, 8am – 5pm.

4. Are there any weekend hauls required from either facility?

No.

5. With respect to servicing each plant, would the driver need to check in with security or the like prior to hauling the box? (i.e., special entrance requirements prior to hauling the box)

No. Each plant is a secured site. The truck driver must call in at the gate to be allowed entrance.

6. Would the County consider modifying its price sheet to allow for quoting a haul rate and then a disposal rate per ton?

No.

7. Would the awarded vendor be required to sign the County's contract? If so, would the County have a draft contract they could share with potential vendors to review?

The contract will include the documents included in the RFQ, the successful company's quote, and an agreement page for signatures.

8. On an average, how many hauls do you have per year between both facilities?

It is anticipated that production will be on the increase for the next few years. Timely dried residuals removal is key to optimal operations and production. There should be 44 hauls for both facilities – inclusive (i.e. 22 hauls each).

9. Why are you having to send the raw water residual to a disposal site? Is this currently going to a MSW landfill? Is this the sediment from the fresh water that is drawn into the plant? Our engineer is curious as to the particulars on this material.

The residuals are from a WATER TREATMENT PROCESS. The treatment process is a surface water treatment scheme. The residuals need to be removed on some routine to allow for continuous and smooth water production. This is not a manifested waste stream. It is currently being disposed at Pine Ridge Landfill.

10. Can you confirm this is not Wastewater treatment residuals? If this is freshwater total suspended solids why must this be disposed of in a landfill?

This is not a wastewater treatment sludge.

11. If you are adding the aluminum and Lime this would be classified as an industrial process, therefore according to RFP requirements for proper disposal a profile is required. Can you provide a profile? If these assumptions or statements are incorrect, can you explain?

Yes. The awarded vendor will receive the profile prior to the start of the contract.

South Fayette Water Treatment Plant will need two (2) roll offs to be supplied.
