**Subject: Request for Proposals #930-P Preliminary Engineering for Redwine
Road Multi-use Path – Addendum #1**

Dear Sir/Madame:

Included herein is additional information and clarification for the above referenced request for proposals. Please consider all of this information when preparing your proposal.

- 1. Will the sealed cost proposals be returned unopened to firms not selected?**
The county must retain for the files any price proposals opened in the course of procuring Preliminary Engineering Services. This would include the firm selected as most highly qualified and, if a negotiated agreement is not reached with that firm, it would include other firm(s) until terms are successfully negotiated. Once the contract is awarded and fully executed, any price proposals remaining unopened will be returned to the firms that submitted them.
- 2. The scope describes a path between Birkdale Drive and Newhaven Drive; however, the map shows the path limits as Birkdale Drive to Old Ivy. Please clarify.**
Currently there is a path along the west side of Redwine Road from South Peachtree Parkway to Old Ivy, and on the east side from Bernhard Road to Newhaven Drive. At a minimum, the project shall construct new path from the Quarters Road/Birkdale Drive intersection to the existing path at Old Ivy. If money allows, and it is deemed appropriate for safety, new path construction may extend down the east side to Newhaven Drive (this “optional” section is not shown on the map). Doing so would allow the residents in Whitewater Creek Subdivision to travel to the school complex without having to cross Redwine Road. One of the goals of the preliminary engineering work is to define these limits for the design-build stage.
- 3. The scope describes a path between Preserve Place and Foreston Place; however, the map shows the path limits as Jefferson Woods Drive to Foreston Place. Please clarify.**
The map is in correct. In this section the new path shall extend from Preserve Place to Foreston Place, presumably on the east side. The attached map shows

the limits correctly. Note that the paths with label of “Proposed Starrs Mill BOE Paths” (i.e., those shown in pink) are not part of this project.

4. **Is there a deadline for additional questions?**

Responder’s Questions: The Fayette County Purchasing Department must receive questions about this request for proposals in writing at least 72 hours before the scheduled proposal opening, excluding Saturdays, Sundays, and holidays. The county will post answers to questions and/or other information concerning the request for proposals in the form of an addendum on the county’s website at http://www.fayettecountyga.gov/purchasing/bids_and_proposals.asp. It is the responsibility of the prospective responder to check the website for any addenda issued for this request for proposals.

Note: If this addendum is not returned to the Fayette County Purchasing Department or if it is returned not signed, all responders shall still be responsible for the requirements of this addendum and the specifications or changes herein.

The opening date for this request for proposal has not changed. The opening date will be 3:00 p.m. Tuesday, February 24, 2015. Proposal must be received in the Purchasing Department at the address listed above in Suite 204 on or before the opening date.

If you have already submitted a proposal, it **will** be opened and read on the opening date. If you would not like your proposal opened at all or should you desire to submit a new proposal, your original proposal must be picked up, or you must notify the Fayette County Purchasing Department **in writing** at the address above of your desire to not have your proposal opened.
