Subject: RFP #1236-B: Resurface Three Roads – Addendum #2

Gentlemen/Ladies:

Included herein is additional information and clarification for the above referenced invitation for bids. Please consider all of this information when preparing your bid.

1. The DBE goal for this project is set by GDOT. In response to comments received by potential bidders, Fayette County has received approval from GDOT for the following change to the DBE goal:

- If the prime Contractor does less than 70% of the work (as measured by invoice), the DBE goal is 13%;
- If the prime Contractor does 70% or more of the work, the DBE goal is 6%.

The bid package should indicate what percentage of the work will be completed by the prime Contractor.

2. Page 22 of the document shows there is a railroad crossing present on the street. Typically a contractor is to stop a certain amount of feet before coming near the railroad or the contractor has to obtain a permit and permission to pave at the railroads; can clarification be provided of what we are to do at the crossroad?

The successful Contractor will be stopping 55' North of the railroad tracks and will resume 33' South of the railroad tracks, see attached.



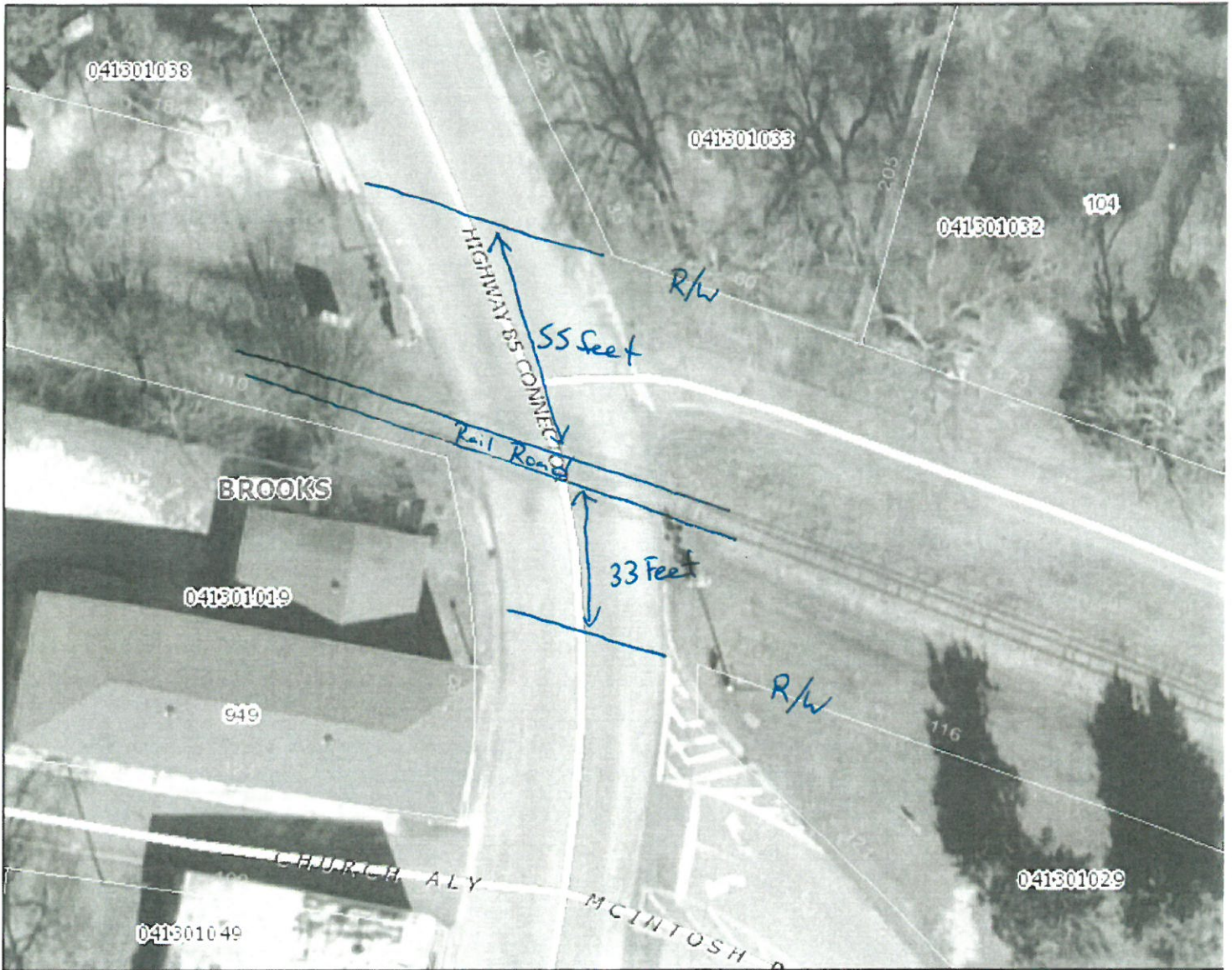
