**Subject: IFB #1236-B: Resurface Three Roads – Addendum #4**

Gentlemen/Ladies:

Included herein is additional information and clarification for the above referenced invitation for bids. Please consider all of this information when preparing your bid.

- 1. The county has responded to question 3 in Addendum #3 by increasing the milling quantity to allow for milling of side roads. Since the project is predominately an overlay project (with the exception of the milling on the section of Hwy 85 connector), then typically milling would not be required on the side roads. Noting, the contractor typically feathers the asphalt out on side roads on overlay projects. As a result, milling of side roads would not be required and the quantity for milling would not need to be increased per Addendum 3.**

**If the county does desire for all side roads to be milled, then the contractor would need to mill the side roads prior to beginning paving operations. As a result of the sequencing for milling side roads, the contractor will need more than the 3 day pave back of milling surfaces as stated in the contract. If the county desires for all side roads to be milled, then will the county consider extending the cover up time for milled surfaces to 15 days or more?**

The County will still require that the large milling section of Hwy 85 Connector in Brooks to be paved back within the 3 day window. All remaining vertical joint tie-ins that are milled out can be left up to 21 days as long as the proper safety notification signage has been installed at each location.


