1. Call to Order by Chair Randy Ognio

Chairman Ognio called the September 4, 2018 Transportation Committee meeting to order at 2:04pm.

5. Report of Committee Members

a. GDOT sent a "Conflict of Interest" letter to all Federal Aid sub-recipients reminding sponsors of no conflict requirements.

b. Interchange project update for I85 & SR 74;

There are two big breakthroughs on the interchange project. GDOT sent a letter to the City of Fairburn stating they have fully authorized all the money needed for the ROW, which will be split-phased. The City of Fairburn also got notice that the ROW plans were approved. The city is on schedule to start ROW acquisitions this fall and construction is estimated for 2021.

c. The SR 74 corridor study project meeting had one of the most productive meetings. The details of how the landscaping recommendations, multiuse paths vs sidewalk, reclamation of zoning, curb cuts and access management. The next meeting is the stakeholder meeting on 9/20/18.

d. Rerouting traffic for Coastline Bridge replacement project;

GDOT is suggesting to route traffic through the Ellens Ridge Subdivision; only local citizens will be able to access the Coastline road during construction.
