1. Call to Order by Chair Randy Ognio

Chairman Ognio called the March 5, 2019 Transportation Committee meeting to order at 2:05pm.

2. Ascertainment of Quorum

Chairman Ognio acknowledged that a Quorum of the Transportation Committee was present.

3. Acceptance of Meeting Agenda

Mrs. Robinson moved to accept the agenda as published. Mrs. Walls second the motion. The motion was passed unanimously.

4. Review and Approval of the February 5, 2018 Transportation Committee Meeting Minutes.

Mrs. Robinson motioned to approve the February 5th meeting minutes as published. Mrs. Walls second the motion. The motion passed 7:3:0 with Mr. Hindman, Lt. Farr and Mrs. Tapp abstaining because they were absent for the February meeting.

5. Report of Committee Members

a. Distribution of GDOT January 2019 project list

Mr. Mallon announced GDOT has assigned a new Project Manager to Fayette County, Shanda Caldwell. She has agreed to will provide the Transportation Committee with Monthly project updates. The project list was distributed to the Committee members and further discussion of Fayette County projects ensued.

Mr. Mallon will follow up with the SR 85 project concerning the change in the speed limit for SR85. The Committee also discussed a follow-up on the SR 85 South bridge project. As GDOT project managers change the promise of creating a historical bridge for the area hasn't been reciprocated by the new managers. The Committee will follow up on the bridge design.

b. SR 74 Corridor Study

Mr. Mallon provided a verbal update to the Committee. The Corridor Study is complete and the draft report was given to local government officials for review and approval. SR 74 gateway corridor meeting is scheduled for March 19th 3:30pm at the Tyrone Library. The Study's final update will be posted to the County's website. The report still needs to go up before the City Councils and Board of Commissioners for adoption.

c. Brodgon Road & New Hope Road Intersection update

The intersection plans are complete and ready for review by the staff. Right of way authorization is needed and will start soon after approval of the plans.

d. GDOT 101

GDOT is having a class Monday, March 11, 2019. The class will be held at GDOT Headquarters in Atlanta from 10am to 12pm. Course content will be on the expectations of GDOT with local official to keep projects moving forward. Everyone is invited with lunch provided. The class will get everyone on the same page. Commissioner Oddo stated this is a good opportunity to have a better relationship with GDOT.

e. ARC Safety Committee

ARC is putting together a safety Committee Quarterly meetings will be held at ARC downtown local office. Meetings will be 3 hours. Chairman Ognio is currently signed up to attend and stated fatality rates are going up and there is a need for more control.

8. New Business

a. Review of RTP Jurisdiction Project Review meeting with ARC – P. Mallon

All projects that get state or federal funding go through an elaborate process to get into the Transportation Improvement Plan (TIP) that covers a 4 year period. The Regional Transportation Plan (RTP) has projects that are unfunded but ready to move into the next batch of TIP projects. The RTP is continuously updated with new projects. The meeting was held March 4, and consisted of reviewing the list of county projects. The Committee reviewed the status of the County's active projects represented on the RTP. See pages 4-5

b. Update on Fayetteville Master Plan and Transportation Initiatives – C. Hindman

Mr. Hindman shares with the Committee details of The City of Fayetteville Master Plan, final results are not ready for posting. Various projects proposed for the City like Lee Street grid network, Grady Road / SR 54 intersection improvement, SR 54 / SR 85 intersection improvements, and Lafayette / downtown area improvements were discussed.

c. Henry County Megasite / Atlanta Speedway Airport – J. Robison

The Fayette County Comprehensive Transportation Plan's Draft Roadway Projects identified a new road (FTP-132) from Goza Road heading east, north of Woolsey, possibly tying into SR 20 in Henry County as a new east/west corridor. Henry County, as part of their Comprehensive Plan recommended a study of 6000 acres laying west of US 19/41, known as the Henry County Megasite. In February 2019, the Study was awarded and is currently underway. Mr. Robison brought these to the attention of the Committee saying, if both Fayette County and Henry County recommended this corridor as a potential project, GDOT would be more inclined to see it as a legitimate project moving forward. Mr. Robison asked the Committee if they would like him to approach Henry County, let them know of Fayette County FTP-132 and ask if Henry County would consider placing it on their consultant's radar to be included as part of the recommended Megasite Master Plan. The Committee agreed and asked Mr. Robison to proceed with communicating with Henry County.

d. East Fayetteville Bypass - Nomenclature & Truck Route Designation - P. Mallon

The design engineers are aware that the East Fayetteville Bypass (EFB) will be a truck route. The Committee will discuss the official start of the road and an appropriate name for the road in April's meeting; a suggestion of Robert Collins Parkway was made.

9. Adjournment

Chairman Ognio asked for a motion to adjourn the meeting. Mrs. Robinson motioned to adjourn the meeting, Mrs. Walls seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously. The meeting was adjourned at 3:41pm
