3. Approval of Agenda- Chair Ungaro made a motion to change agenda order by placing the Safe Streets and Roads for All (SS4A) Baseline Report Presentation first in the new business segment of the agenda. Motion was made to accept amended agenda by Rabun/Borkowski was approved (9:0).

    - No update
  - b. Fayette County – Phil Mallon, Public Works
    - The installation of the all-way stop for Hampton Rd, Antioch Rd and Winn Way is set for December 10, 2024.
    - The clearing phase of the Redwine Tunnel Project commenced on December 2, 2024. It is estimated that the majority of the clearing will be completed December 20, 2024.
    - Due to the reported concerns about the safety at the intersection of SR 74 and SR 85, Fayette County will review the crash data to get a better understanding of trends that are happening at that intersection. The County will share the data and all mitigating measures with GDOT, with a possible update in January 2025.
    - Due to rezoning and possible development along SR 74 S, GDOT conducted a traffic study and is proposing an RCUT at the intersection of SR 74 S and Brechin Drive.

- Next week the County is moving forward with the acceptance of the 2025 CTP ARC Grant and will immediately start the bid process.

- Currently working on Intergovernmental Agreement (IGA) with Fayette County to repave South Sandy Creek. Fayette County has completed the Bid process, and it is now with the Fayetteville City Council for approval.
